Dear Friends,

Today we celebrate Good Shepherd Sunday. Shepherding is one of the oldest professions in the Bible. Genesis 4:2 says, "Now Abel was a keeper of flocks..." Many of the men and women of the Bible were shepherds: Abel, Abraham, Isaac, Jacob, Lot, Laban, Moses, Rachel, David, Amos.



The duties of a shepherd in Palestine were very hard. In early morning he led forth the flock from the fold, marching at its head to the place where they would pasture. Here he watched them all day, taking care that none of the sheep strayed, and if any for a time eluded his watch and wandered away from the rest, seeking diligently till he found and brought it back.

One duty of the shepherd was to protect the sheep from predators. Wolves were the worst enemy of the flock. If a sheep falls into running water, it will drown, their woolly coats soak up quickly and sheep cannot swim. He needs to be led to calm waters. Sheep nibble on grass, all day, all the time. One or two usually tend to wander away from the flock and get lost.

After eating, sheep need to digest what they have eaten by lying down, but sometimes they won't lie down on their own. They need to be made to lie down.

When his day is done and all sheep are accounted for, whatever kind of sheepfold he has brought the flock into, the shepherd will sleep across the door to protect the sheep while they sleep. If a predator tries to enter, the shepherd will awaken and beat it back. He will do the same against thieves too.

A day in the life of a shepherd was difficult, but worthwhile. God chose to give many of our Bible heroes the job of shepherd, and to One, He gave the highest job of all. Jesus is THE GOOD SHEPHERD.

Queridos amigos,

Hoy celebramos el Domingo del Buen Pastor. El pastoreo es una de las profesiones más antiguas en la Biblia. Génesis 4:2 dice: "Abel fue pastor de ovejas..." Muchos hombres y mujeres de la Biblia fueron pastores: Abel, Abraham, Isaac, Jacob, Lot, Labán, Moisés, Raquel, David, Amós.



Las labores de un pastor en Palestina eran muy duras. Por la mañana temprano, él sacaba al rebaño del redil, liderándolo hacia el lugar donde pastarían. Aquí los vigilaba todo el día, asegurándose de que ninguna oveja se extraviara, y si alguna eludía su vigilancia y se alejaba del resto, la buscaba diligentemente hasta encontrarla y traerla de vuelta.

Una de las responsabilidades del pastor era proteger a las ovejas de los depredadores. Los lobos eran el peor enemigo del rebaño. Si una oveja cae en aguas corrientes, se ahogará, ya que su grueso pelaje se empapa rápidamente y las ovejas no pueden nadar. Necesita ser llevada a aguas tranquilas. Las ovejas pastan hierba todo el día, todo el tiempo. Una o dos suelen separarse del rebaño y perderse.

Después de comer, las ovejas necesitan digerir lo que han comido acostándose, pero a veces no se acuestan por sí solas. Necesitan ser obligadas a acostarse.

Cuando termina su día y todas las ovejas están contabilizadas, el pastor se acuesta frente a la puerta para proteger a las ovejas mientras duermen. Si un depredador intenta entrar, el pastor se despierta y lo repele. También hará lo mismo contra los ladrones.

Un día en la vida de un pastor era difícil, pero valía la pena. Dios eligió darle a muchos de nuestros héroes bíblicos el trabajo de pastor, y a Uno, le dio el trabajo más alto de todos. Jesús es EL BUEN PASTOR.

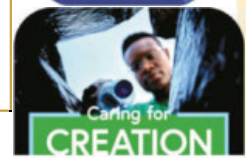
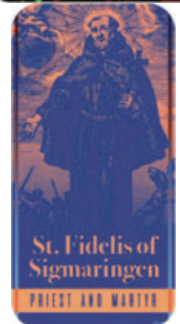
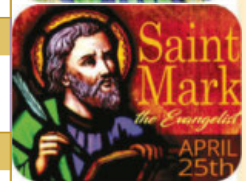

(20) Chúa Giêsu Gặp Gỡ Ta Nơi Các Bí Tích (1)

Từ nguồn sung mãn của Ngài, tất cả chúng ta đã lãnh nhận hết ơn này đến ơn khác. (Ga 1,14.16-18)

1. H. Bí Tích là gì?

T. Bí Tích là những dấu chỉ Chúa Giêsu thiết lập, và trao cho Hội Thánh để ban sự sống thần linh cho ta.

2. H. Trong các Bí Tích, Chúa Giêsu tiếp tục công việc cứu chuộc thế nào?

T. Khi Hội Thánh cử hành các bí tích, thì chính Chúa Giêsu hành động với quyền năng Chúa Thánh Thần mà ban ơn cứu chuộc cho ta.

3. H. Có mấy bí tích?

T. Có 7 bí tích:

- Một là bí tích Rửa Tội.
- Hai là bí tích Thêm Sức.
- Ba là bí tích Thánh Thể.
- Bốn là bí tích Giải Tội.
- Năm là bí tích Xức Dầu Bệnh Nhân.
- Sáu là bí tích Truyền Chức Thánh.
- Bảy là bí tích Hôn Phối.

(21) Chúa Giêsu Gặp Gỡ Ta Nơi Các Bí Tích (2)

Trong Đức Kitô, từ cõi trời, Thiên Chúa đã thi ân giáng phúc cho ta hưởng muôn vàn ơn phúc của Thánh Thần. (Ep 1,3)

1. H. Những bí tích nào chỉ được lãnh nhận một lần mà thôi?

T. Có ba bí tích này:

- Một là Rửa Tội.
- Hai là Thêm Sức.
- Ba là Truyền Chức Thánh.

2. H. Trong 7 bí tích có bí tích nào trọng hơn không?

T. Có bí tích Thánh thể trọng hơn, vì bí tích này ban cho ta chính Chúa Giêsu là nguồn mọi ơn phúc.

3. H. Để lãnh nhận các bí tích cho nên thì ta phải làm gì?

T. Muốn lãnh nhận bí tích Rửa Tội và Giải Tội, ta phải có lòng thống hối, còn các bí tích khác phải sạch tội trọng mới được lãnh nhận. Đồng thời ta phải có lòng tin, có ý ngay lành, thành thật ước muốn và giữ sự nghiêm trang sốt sắng.

• Suy Niệm: Chúa Nhật 4 Phục Sinh

Đức Giêsu chính là vị Mục Tử nhân lành luôn yêu thương và quan tâm dẫn dắt đoàn chiên của mình. Chúa nói rằng Ngài là cửa chuồng chiên. Chuồng chiên chính là Giáo Hội được bảo vệ bằng các giới răn của Chúa. Ai trung thành nghe tuân giữ và liên kết với Ngài thì được vào Nước Trời. Nghĩa là được đến cùng Thiên Chúa Cha, nguồn mạch sự sống và hạnh phúc trường sinh.

Lạy Chúa Giêsu, chúng con như chiên lạc, lang thang bơ vơ đói khổ, vì thiếu dòng suối mát, vì thiếu đồng cỏ xanh, vì thiếu vị mục tử chân chính. Xin Chúa đến hướng dẫn, điều dắt chúng con về nước tình yêu của Chúa. Vì chính Chúa là cửa an toàn, vì chính Chúa là vị mục tử nhân hiền. Chỉ trong Chúa, chúng con mới được nghỉ ngơi yên lành. Amen.

Hôm nay Chúa Nhật Chúa Chiên Lành. Đức Thánh Cha đã chọn ngày này là ngày "Thế Giới Cầu Nguyện Cho Ôn Gội". Ngày mẹ Hội Thánh cũng muốn mỗi người chúng ta thêm lời cầu nguyện, để Giáo Hội càng ngày càng có thêm nhiều mục tử biết sống theo mẫu gương Chúa Giêsu, Vị Mục Tử Nhân Lành.

Thánh Thể là Nguồn Mạch và tột Đỉnh Của việc Rao Giảng Tin Mừng (tiếp theo)

Công đồng Vaticanô II dạy: Bí tích Thánh Thể tự cho thấy chính nó là nguồn mạch và là tột đỉnh của toàn thể công việc rao giảng Tin Mừng. Những người dưới sự hướng dẫn được giới thiệu theo từng giai đoạn đến việc tham dự vào Bí tích Thánh Thể, và các tín hữu, đã được đóng ấn của Bí tích Rửa tội và Thêm sức, qua việc lãnh nhận Bí tích Thánh Thể được kết hợp trọn vẹn vào Thân Mình Đức Kitô.

Thánh Phaolô nhấn mạnh rằng sự hiệp thông này không chỉ tồn tại giữa chúng ta, mà còn với những người đến trước chúng ta. Khi ngó lời với Hội Thánh tại Côrintô, Ngài ca ngợi họ vì đã tuân giữ các truyền thống, như tôi đã truyền lại cho anh em (1Cor 11,2). Sau đó, ngài nhấn mạnh Bí tích Thánh Thể như một truyền thống thánh được Đức Kitô truyền lại cho các tông đồ, và trong đó giờ đây chúng ta chia sẻ: Vì tôi đã nhận được từ Chúa điều gì, tôi cũng đã truyền lại cho anh (1Cor 11,23). Trong mỗi Thánh Lễ, chúng ta được kết hợp với tất cả những người nam nữ thánh thiện, các thánh, là những người đã đi trước chúng ta.

We achieve this goal by creating opportunities for encountering our Lord Jesus Christ and fostering communities that accompany and support each other on their faith journeys. “The One” is our preamble for an enduring Eucharistic Renewal, and is centered on encounter and accompaniment, and experiencing the truth, beauty and goodness of our faith.

A deep relationship with the person of Jesus Christ begins with an encounter—an experience of God that moves us, inspires us, challenges us, and improves us. We then accompany each other on our faith journey, in which we witness Truth (our absolute faith in God) Beauty (the engagement of heart in the faith) and Goodness (works of mercy). Through encountering our Lord Jesus Christ, and by embracing the truth, beauty, and goodness of our faith, we will, together, fall in love with God in the ultimate encounter with Christ: the Holy Eucharist and Sunday Mass.

BRIDGEPORT DIOCESE EUCHARISTIC PROCESSION

On Pentecost Sunday, May 19, the Blessed Sacrament arrives from the Archdiocese of Hartford to Bridgeport. Thus begins our joyful and profound four-day encounter with the Holy Eucharist. Hundreds of faithful will march through Bridgeport, with Corpus Christi-style Eucharistic Stations and Adoration at five parishes.

As the procession proceeds through eight towns and 19 parishes, our days, evenings and nights will be filled with Masses, local processions, Holy Hours and overnight Adoration. A Rosary procession will be held at Saint John Cemetery in Norwalk and at the Saint Margaret Shrine in Bridgeport. Local town processions will occur in Ridgefield, Norwalk, Stamford and Greenwich, and several parishes will host campus processions. Each morning begins with the celebration of Mass; each evening ends with overnight Adoration. Events are designed to inspire all Church faithful to attend and will engage schoolchildren, young adults and all ethnic groups.

Beginning on Thursday, May 23 and for the nine days that follow, special events for all parishes will occur in every region within our diocese, including Adoration, Masses and processions. Our joyful 14 days will culminate with a Mass of Thanksgiving at Fairfield University on the morning of June 1, with over 3,500 faithful expected to attend.
