




Pastor's Corner

Dear Friends,

"This is the day the Lord has made; let us rejoice and be glad!" (Psalm 118:24)

Today, we celebrate the heart of our Christian faith—the Resurrection of Jesus Christ. Easter is not simply a remembrance of a past event, but a living reality that continues to shape and transform our lives today. The empty tomb proclaims a truth the world still struggles to fully grasp: death is not the end, and hope is never in vain. Christ is risen, and in Him, we rise too.



In the first reading from Acts, Peter boldly proclaims the Good News: Jesus, anointed with the Holy Spirit, went about doing good, suffered death, and was raised by God on the third day. He reminds us that we are now the witnesses, called to carry that same message of life and forgiveness into a world weary with division, violence, and despair.

Saint Paul, in the second reading, invites us to “seek what is above,” to lift our hearts and thoughts beyond the passing struggles of this world. With ongoing global conflicts, economic uncertainty, and personal suffering that many continue to carry, Easter challenges us to live as people who believe in the power of new beginnings. We are not defined by the tombs we find ourselves in—be it grief, sin, or discouragement. Through Christ, we are called out of darkness and into the light.

And yet, even those closest to Jesus didn’t recognize the miracle right away. In the Gospel of John, Mary Magdalene, Peter, and John find an empty tomb but not immediate clarity. Sometimes, even in the face of grace, our understanding lags behind. But like the beloved disciple, we are invited to see and believe—to trust that God is working, even when we don’t yet see the whole picture.

Today, in our parishes and homes, in our hearts and streets, the Church rings with the ancient hymn of Easter joy: “Christ is risen! Alleluia!” May this Easter be more than a celebration—it must be a call to action. Let us leave behind the “old yeast” of fear, bitterness, and indifference. Let us become “a fresh batch” of people marked by sincerity, hope, and peace. In our world today, more than ever, resurrection people are needed—those who live with joy, love boldly, and reflect the light of the Risen Christ.

As we gather with loved ones, feast, and rejoice, may our hearts burn with the same fire that sent the disciples running from the tomb—not in fear, but in mission. Christ is risen, and because of that, everything has changed.

Alleluia! He is truly risen. Happy Easter!

May God bless you always!

Queridos amigos,

“Este es el día que hizo el Señor: regocijémonos y alegrémonos en Él.” (Salmo 118,24)

Hoy celebramos el corazón de nuestra fe cristiana: la Resurrección de Jesucristo. La Pascua no es simplemente el recuerdo de un evento del pasado, sino una realidad viva que continúa dando forma y sentido a nuestras vidas hoy. El sepulcro vacío proclama una verdad que el mundo aún lucha por comprender: la muerte no tiene la última palabra, y la esperanza nunca es en vano. Cristo ha resucitado, y con Él, nosotros también resucitamos.



En la primera lectura del libro de los Hechos, Pedro proclama con valentía la Buena Nueva: Jesús, ungido con el Espíritu Santo, pasó haciendo el bien, sufrió la muerte, y fue resucitado por Dios al tercer día. Nos recuerda que ahora nosotros somos los testigos, llamados a llevar ese mismo mensaje de vida y perdón a un mundo cansado de divisiones, violencia y desesperanza.

San Pablo, en la segunda lectura, nos invita a “buscar las cosas de arriba”, a elevar nuestros corazones más allá de las luchas pasajeras de este mundo. En medio de los conflictos globales, la incertidumbre económica y el sufrimiento personal que muchos aún viven, la Pascua nos desafía a vivir como personas que creen en el poder de los nuevos comienzos. No estamos definidos por los sepulcros en los que podamos estar—ya sea el duelo, el pecado o el desánimo. Por Cristo, somos llamados a salir de la oscuridad hacia la luz.

Y sin embargo, incluso aquellos más cercanos a Jesús no comprendieron el milagro de inmediato. En el Evangelio según San Juan, María Magdalena, Pedro y Juan encuentran el sepulcro vacío, pero no una comprensión clara. A veces, incluso frente a la gracia, nuestra comprensión tarda en llegar. Pero como el discípulo amado, estamos invitados a ver y creer, a confiar en que Dios está obrando, aunque no veamos todo con claridad.

Hoy, en nuestras parroquias y hogares, en nuestros corazones y calles, la Iglesia canta con gozo pascual: **“¡Cristo ha resucitado! ¡Aleluya!”** Que esta Pascua sea más que una celebración: que sea un llamado a la acción. Dejemos atrás la “levadura vieja” del miedo, la amargura y la indiferencia. Seamos “una masa nueva” de personas marcadas por la sinceridad, la esperanza y la paz. En nuestro mundo actual, más que nunca, se necesitan personas pascuales—que vivan con alegría, amen con valentía y reflejen la luz de Cristo Resucitado.

Al reunirnos con nuestros seres queridos, al celebrar y alegrarnos, que nuestros corazones arden con el mismo fuego que hizo correr a los discípulos desde el sepulcro—no por miedo, sino por misión. Cristo ha resucitado, y por eso, todo ha cambiado.

¡Aleluya! Verdaderamente ha resucitado. ¡Feliz Pascua!

¡Que Dios te bendiga siempre!







Chúng ta hãy reo mừng:

HALLELUIA!!!

Chúa Phục Sinh là điều quan trọng đối với Kitô Giáo. Đức Phật đã chết. Mohammad đã chết. Moses đã chết. Không Tử đã chết. Tuy nhiên, theo Thiên Chúa Giáo, Chúa Kitô đã sống lại.

1. Chúa Giêsu nói trước về điều này

Trước khi Ngài chết, Chúa Giêsu nói với các môn đệ rằng Ngài sẽ bị phản bội, bị bắt và chịu đóng đinh, và rằng Ngài sẽ sống lại ba ngày sau đó. Không có một người sáng lập của bất cứ tôn giáo nào trên thế giới có thể dám nói một điều như vậy.

2. Giáo hội chống lại những phủ nhận về Chúa Giêsu Phục sinh

(1). Ngôi Mộ Trống?

Làm thế nào có thể các vệ sĩ La Mã để cho xác Chúa Giêsu bị ăn cắp? Không thể nào có bất cứ ai qua mặt được các vệ này và đã chuyển một hòn đá nặng hai tấn. Nếu xác của Chúa Giêsu được tìm thấy ở bất cứ nơi nào, kẻ thù của Ngài sẽ lập tức phát giác sự sống lại như là một âm mưu gian trá.

(2). Câu chuyện bị đặt?

Trong thế kỷ đầu tiên, phụ nữ hầu như không có quyền, nhân vị, hoặc danh dự. Nếu muốn âm mưu thành công, những kẻ chủ mưu phải chọn người đàn ông là người đầu tiên nhìn thấy Chúa Giêsu sống lại.

Nếu dựng chuyện thì có ai dám chết vì câu chuyện giả tưởng không?! Thế mà hầu hết các tông đồ và các môn đệ thời kỳ đầu tiên đều chịu chết để bảo vệ chân lý này.

(3). Các Môn Đệ Bị Áo Giác?

Áo giác là một biến cố riêng lẻ. Chỉ có một người có thể nhìn thấy một áo giác được trong một thời điểm. Nó chắc chắn không phải là một cái gì đó mà có thể được nhìn thấy bởi một nhóm người. Nhưng đây, Chúa Phục Sinh hiện ra với nhiều người, ở nhiều thời điểm và thời gian khác nhau!

Kết luận: Thánh Phaolô quả quyết: "Nếu Chúa Giê-su đã chẳng sống lại, thì sự giảng dạy của chúng tôi ra uổng công và đức tin anh em cũng ra vô ích!"

Thánh Tôma nói với chúng ta: "Phúc cho những ai không thấy mà tin!"
