
New School Principal

Respect Life Ministry — What if Article 22 is Defeated?

If Vermont voters defeat Article 22 in November, and abortion is not "enshrined" in the Vermont Constitution, will abortion then be illegal in Vermont? NO! Vermont already has in place a law, Act 47, guaranteeing a woman's right to abortion through all nine months of pregnancy, up to and including the day of birth. Act 47, passed in 2019 by Vermont legislators and signed into law by Gov. Phil Scott on June 10, 2019, preserves a woman's right to abortion. Also, if Roe vs. Wade is overturned, Vermont women — and women who come to Vermont from out-of- state will continue to have the right to seek an abortion up to and including during labor without having Article 22 in the Vermont Constitution. 4th Sunday of Easter


