
#### Online Bereavement Support Group from Catholic Charities NH

## January 3, 2021—The Epiphany of the Lord

Why did the magi present gifts of gold, frankincense and myrrh to Jesus??

Those gifts show that they recognized who Jesus is: Gold: he is King, Frankincense (*incense used in the Temple*): he is God and Myrrh (*used to prepare bodies before burial*): he is human.

So it hit me...**what we give others speaks to what we believe about them.**

If I give people coldness and rudeness, does it not convey that I believe they are stupid or are a nuisance?

If I ignore others, does it not express that I believe they are insignificant?

If I am kind, patient and encouraging toward people, does it not communicate that they are of great value?

If I believe God's Word in Genesis 1:27 (*We were created in God's image and likeness*) and if I am to take Jesus seriously in Matthew 25:40 when He says what we do for the least, we do for Him, then I am challenged to see with a new pair of eyes! And with this new vision... and new heart... I am to give each person '*gifts*' that reflect who they are at their core. I am to offer '*gifts*' that convey that they are made in God's image and likeness (*whether or not they are being God-like*). I am to present '*gifts*' that show that I recognize Christ is in them. To be able

to do this, I really need to get into Christ-shape and so I commit to daily exercise... 10 minutes of sitting silently in God's loving presence: dropping all thoughts and conversations and waiting patiently for Grace to take root and transform my seeing! Will you join with expectant hope for daily Epiphanies? May we grow into the Body of Christ,

**Pope Declares 2021 as Year of St. Joseph** In making his declaration, Pope Francis noted that this year marks the 150th anniversary of the saint's proclamation as patron of the Universal Church by Pope Pius IX on Dec. 8, 1870.

Pope Francis said the coronavirus pandemic has heightened his desire to reflect on St. Joseph, as so many people during the pandemic have made hidden sacrifices to protect others, just as St. Joseph quietly protected and cared for Mary and Jesus.

"Each of us can discover in Joseph -- the man who goes unnoticed, a daily, discreet and hidden presence -- an intercessor, a support and a guide in times of trouble," the pope wrote.

He also said he wanted to highlight St. Joseph's role as a father who served his family with charity and humility, adding, "Our world today needs fathers."

## Faith Formation 2020-2021

The online Faith Formation portion, Monday elementary youth ministry and the Wednesday Middle School Classes are on Christmas break from December 22 to Jan 3<sup>rd</sup>. Elementary Youth Ministry resumes with a Christmas Party on January 4<sup>th</sup> and middle school classes resume January 6<sup>th</sup>.



These are some ways God showed up to some of our Faith Formation families and what they believe  
God is trying to tell them:

The trees in the backyard formed a cross: God is always with me!

I went to get a Playstation 5 and they were out of stock. My family offered to help. God is showing me how to accept help from others.

I saw a bald eagle. God is saying, even if we don't see something a lot of ever, it doesn't mean it's not true.

K was in quarantine. God was telling him to be thankful for what he has.

When my mom was praying in the shower she looked to the left and there was a cross made out of water! God was telling her everything will be ok.

Mom spread fertilizer under the bushes and needed to water them so they fertilizer would soak in. All day she kept saying she had to get back outside and water the bushes, then it got dark. We woke up to rain- God watered the bushes!

### What special graces are available during this year of St. Joseph?

As Catholics pray and reflect on the life of St. Joseph throughout the coming year, they also have opportunities to gain a plenary indulgence, or remission of all temporal punishment due to sin. An indulgence can be applied to oneself or to a soul in Purgatory.

An indulgence requires a specific act, defined by the Church, as well as sacramental confession, Eucharistic Communion, prayer for the pope's intentions, and full detachment from sin. Special indulgences during the Year of St. Joseph can be received through **more than a dozen different prayers and actions**, including praying for the unemployed, entrusting one's daily work to St. Joseph, performing a corporal or spiritual work of mercy, or meditating for at least 30 minutes on the Lord's Prayer.




