Eucharistic Adoration & the Divine Presence

The slower pace of the summer offers us time to meditate on the gift of the Blessed Sacrament.

Within our parish, we have multiple times and places where you can spend time in Eucharistic Adoration. Eucharistic adoration is the act of worshipping God as He is present in the consecrated Eucharist. Spending time before the Blessed Sacrament, in prayer and devotion, is the same as spending time before the living God.

Adoration occurs whenever someone kneels in front of a tabernacle that contains the Blessed Sacrament, genuflects toward a tabernacle, bows before receiving the Blessed Sacrament at Mass, or, in a more focused way, when the Blessed Sacrament is exposed for adoration. The purpose of adoration is to highlight the presence of Our Lord in the Eucharist. When a consecrated host is placed in the monstrance, it is said to be solemn adoration.

'Flat Jesus'!




