

In my early twenties I was asked by my spiritual director to describe how I saw God. I explained that I envisioned God with white hair and a beard, sitting up in the clouds watching everything below. My director asked if God heard me when I prayed. I answered that I believed He heard me, but that He wasn't really listening. My director then asked me to tell him about my dad. I explained how my dad was a man of deep faith, a hard worker, but that I didn't remember seeing him much during my childhood because of his air force duties and travel, though I did recall him sitting in a chair reading the newspaper and my talking to him and his occasionally replying "*mhmm*" without looking up... and there it was! My dad was hearing my voice but wasn't really listening! The experience of my earthly dad helped shape my image of God! I was then challenged to consider God as Mother. In reflecting on the Bible passages that describe God as mother (*for example Isaiah 49, Isaiah 66 and Psalm 131*), my experience of my mom (*her endless generosity, support, concern, love, creativity, hospitality*), and now my being a mom (*with the depth of love I still can't fathom, with the concern and desire to give that knows no limit, etc.*), I have grown to know and understand and experience God in the most powerful ways!!!


