

LENTEN REGULATIONS

Catholics, 14 years of age and older, are to abstain from meat on Ash Wednesday and on all Fridays in Lent.

Norms on fasting are obligatory from age 18 until age 59. When fasting, a person is permitted to eat one full meal, as well as two smaller meals that together are not equal to a full meal.

The rule does not apply when health or ability to work would be seriously impacted. In dubious cases, consult the Pastor for dispensation.





Meats – Symbolic of the Lamb once Slain

Eggs – Symbolic of the Resurrection

Breads- Reminds us of Jesus, who is true Bread of Life.

Blessing of Easter Baskets is one of the most enduring and beloved Easter traditions. Baskets containing a sampling of Easter foods are brought to church to be blessed on Holy Saturday. The basket is traditionally lined with a white linen or lace napkin and decorated with sprigs of boxwood the typical Easter evergreen. Observing the beautiful foods and creations of other parishioners is one of the special joys of the event.

The Blessing of the Food is a festive occasion. The three-part blessing prayers specifically address the various contents of the basket, with special prayers for the meats, eggs, cakes & breads.


