Said "NO" to Pope Clement VII when asked to assume leadership of an Order of Nursing Nuns. She had just returned from a trip to the Holy Land. On the way there she had fallen ill and become blind. Nevertheless, she insisted on continuing her pilgrimage and toured the holy sites with the devotion of her heart rather than her eyes. On the way back she had recovered her sight. But this must have been a reminder to her not to shut her eyes to the needs she saw around her, not to shut her heart to God's call. She took a life of educating young girls and dedicating her life to following God's call.

*Prayer: Saint Angela, you were not afraid of change. You did not let stereotypes keep you from serving. Help us to overcome our fear of change in order to follow God's call and allow others to follow theirs.*

Research shows that married adults have longer lives, have better health and greater personal happiness (Why Marriage Matters, a Report from Family Scholars, third edition). The Diocese of Burlington begins National Marriage Week with Mass at St. Joseph Cathedral in Burlington on Feb. 6 at 10 a.m. celebrated by Burlington Bishop Christopher Coyne.
