

## PASTOR'S COLUMN

With a couple of heat waves already behind us this summer and when going into a supermarket, it is not a surprise to see towers of soda and other soft drinks displayed for sale. There has been a change over the years to more healthy preferences than soda for a good summer drink when the temperatures are rising. However, for many people, the choice remains an "ice-cold can of Coke"! To be honest, this should not come as a surprise. Here is why...

From an unknown source it is said that 97% of the world has heard of Coca-Cola; and 72% of the world has seen a can of Coke; in addition, 51% of the world has tasted Coca-Cola. The remarkable thing is that Coke has only been around 135 years. We can only imagine if God had given the task of world evangelization to the Coca-Cola Company, the mission Christ gave to his Church would probably be completed by now!

Of course, this conclusion is ridiculous and nonsensical. Among other things, there is a major difference between having a refreshing drink on a warm summer's day and embracing the life to which we are called in Christ. One offers temporary relief; the other holds the promise of salvation. One provides an instant fix; the other has eternal implications.

The mission of Christ will exist until the Lord Jesus returns in his glory to claim all for the Kingdom of God. And the fact is that Christ does not want to do so alone. The Lord wants our collaboration. Christ wants us to help him bring his sheep to his kingdom. As Christians who know the value of belonging to the community of the Church, we are called to invite those who want a deeper relationship with Jesus Christ to join us as we continue our own personal journey with the Lord.

## SUNDAY MASS OBLIGATION REINSTATE

Aware that the opportunity to participate in Sunday Mass is now widely available and increasingly safe for our Catholic people, Cardinal Sean has lifted the dispensation from the Sunday and Holy Day Mass obligation, which was granted during the pandemic. This does not apply to those who are ill, those who have been recently exposed to COVID or any other communicable illness, those who are confined to their homes or other facilities due to illness, infirmity, or age, and those who are not yet able to be vaccinated due to age or health consideration. Our parishes will continue to livestream Sunday and weekday Masses for people in these circumstances. To those who have not been with us during this past year, we look forward to welcoming you back to the celebration of Mass at Holy Family and St. Irene Parishes!

As you grab for that relaxing drink this summer to refresh your thirst, I am sure you will be thankful for the respite it provides – even if only temporary. Be sure, however, to also claim the 'ultimate thirst quencher' which is God's eternal love for you. Offer others the opportunity to share in that love each time and every time we celebrate the Eucharist.

## Fifteenth Sunday in Ordinary Time

Am 7:12-15 | Eph 1:3-14 or 1:3-10 | Mk 6:7-13

### GROW AS A DISCIPLE | PRAY, STUDY, ENGAGE, SERVE

I don't know about you, but even for the quickest of errands I don't like to leave my house without my smartphone. Nor would I go on a road trip without my trusty mini-Diet Coke and a snack or two. So I'm struck by what Jesus tells the Apostles when he sends them on their mission to share the Good News: "He instructed them to take nothing for the journey but a walking stick - no food, no sack, no money in their belts." While it may be hard for us to imagine striking out with only the sandals on our feet, to me this reading is more about what the Apostles *did* have than what they went without: They had a companion (Jesus sent them two by two) and the spiritual blessings Saint Paul refers to, including a relationship with Jesus and absolute trust in him. Today's readings remind us to set aside distractions and spend time deepening our relationship with Jesus through prayer, reading the Scriptures, and participating in the sacramental life of the Church. In doing so, we, too, can join in the mission of the early disciples by giving our lives to Jesus and sharing his message with others.

### GO EVANGELIZE

PRAYER, INVITATION, WITNESS, ACCOMPANIMENT

I find the phrase "the new evangelization" somewhat ironic. After all, evangelization is not new, it goes back to the earliest days of the Church, which wouldn't exist had it not been for the disciples. The "new" part reminds us that we today also share in this mission. The U.S. Catholic bishops describe it succinctly: "The New Evangelization calls each of us to deepen our faith, believe in the Gospel message and go forth to proclaim the Gospel." This call is both simple, and challenging, but we don't have to be perfect. After all, just as God called Amos, a humble shepherd, and Jesus called the Twelve, a motley group of fishermen, he calls us. Like them, our first "task" isn't a task at all - it is placing God and our relationship with Jesus at the center of our lives. Only then can we effectively share the Gospel with others, inviting our brothers and sisters to a life in Christ - to become part of God's adopted family.

### WITNESS

At the end of Sunday Mass, we often hear the words: "Go in peace, glorifying the Lord by your life." As we are sent forth, let us ask God to show us how we can share the Gospel with others during the week ahead. Then pay attention to where the Spirit leads us in answering our prayer.

## DISCIPLES IN MISSION

### LIVE THE LITURGY INSPIRATION FOR THE WEEK

God calls us to bring His Word to all corners of the earth. What does that mean for you and me? We are just simple and humble folks trying to find our way through the Gospel and our world. After all, we are not professional preachers but gentle servants. Jesus summons us to take his message on the road and bring it from the pew to the pavement. We cannot keep the joy of the Gospel to ourselves but must bring it into every aspect of our lives: our families, our schools, our work, our corporations, our politics, our social circles, and our philosophies. We cannot just accept the wisdom of the world as true and conduct our lives as if the Good News is a separate matter. They are one. Jesus never asked his friends to go and construct buildings where people could come to hear the truth. He asked them to go to their homes and meet them one on one, face to face. When the rubber meets the road and the message is challenging, rejection is quite possible. That's the litmus test for whether we're really doing what we have been asked.
