

Dear Parish Family,

We are fast approaching the month of May, which is fittingly dedicated to Our Lady, the Mother of Christ and our spiritual mother. It is a great practice during the month of May to find some particular, concrete way to honor the Blessed Virgin Mary. Some popular devotions to Our Lady include praying the *Memorare*, or reciting the *Angelus* prayer at either 6:00 a.m., 12 noon or 6:00 p.m. (replaced by the *Regina Coeli* during the Easter season), wearing her brown scapular or the Miraculous Medal, praying the rosary or the Litany of the Blessed Virgin Mary, and honoring Our Lady through small acts of love and sacrifice.

Next weekend, May 2 & 3, we will have a May Crowning at all of our weekend Masses here at St. Joseph's. A May Crowning is a beautiful symbol of our love and devotion to the Blessed Mother. It is like bringing flowers to your earthly mother on Mother's Day. I encourage you to think about how you might honor Our Lady in your home as a family. You could pray the rosary together (or even just one decade) each day; set up a prayer table in your home with a candle, open Bible, and a statue or image of the Blessed Mother; have a special shrine in your backyard, or you might consider having your own family May Crowning. These are wonderful ways to grow in faith together as a family.

May also brings to mind the sacrament of First Holy Communion for our second graders. Let's keep them in our prayers in the weeks ahead as they prepare to receive Jesus' Body and Blood for the first time on Saturday, May 15.




GOSPEL
