With a Father's Heart



Dear Parish Family,

This coming Wednesday, December 8 we will celebrate the Solemnity of the Immaculate Conception and the conclusion to the Year of St. Joseph. The Solemnity of the Immaculate Conception is sometimes confused with Our Lord's conception in Mary's womb. However, it is actually when Our Lady was conceived in the womb of her own mother, St. Anne. We remember that Mary was conceived completely free of original sin and remained sinless throughout her entire life. And exactly nine months after December 8, the Church celebrates the birthday of Mary on September 8. The Church remembers the conception of Jesus exactly nine months before Christmas, on March 25 when we celebrate the Annunciation.

But why do we celebrate the end of the Year of St. Joseph on December 8? The reason is that it was exactly one year ago, on December 8, 2020, that Pope Francis proclaimed a holy Year of St. Joseph for the Church. The reason he chose this date was because it marked the 150th anniversary when Pope Pius IX declared St. Joseph as Patron of the Universal Church on December 8, 1870. Pope Pius IX also raised St. Joseph's feast day (March 19) to the rank of double of the first class (today that feast ranks as a Solemnity). Here is an excerpt from Pope Pius IX's declaration:

And now therefore, when in these most troublesome times the Church is beset by enemies on every side, and is weighed down by calamities so heavy that ungodly men assert that the gates of hell have at length prevailed against her, the venerable prelates of the whole Catholic world have presented to the Sovereign Pontiff their own petitions and those of the faithful committed to their charge, praying that he would deign to constitute St. Joseph Patron of the Church... Accordingly, it has now pleased our Most Holy Sovereign, Pope Pius IX, in order to entrust himself and all the faithful to the Patriarch St. Joseph's most powerful patronage, has chosen to comply with the prelates' desire and has solemnly declared him Patron of the Catholic Church.

The conclusion of the Year of St. Joseph will be a special day for our parish as we will have 3 Masses, a Eucharistic procession, all day adoration with Exposition and Benediction, renewal of our parish consecration to St. Joseph at all three Masses, re-dedication of our newly restored outdoor statue of St. Joseph & the Christ Child and a light reception after the 7 pm Mass. Please mark your calendar and join us for as long as your schedule allows. There are still a number of slots open for adoration. If you haven't already, please sign up for a half hour slot using the Sign Up Genius link in my Flocknote. It's important that we don't leave Our Lord unattended throughout the day. If you aren't comfortable with the Sign Up Genius, please feel free to call the Parish Office and we can reserve a slot for you. Let's make this a celebration to remember!

2022 Confirmation Rite of Enrollment

The 2022 Confirmation Rite of Enrollment was held with the Confirmation Candidates and their parents on December 4th at the 5:00 pm Mass. The Rite of Enrollment ceremony marks the beginning of a "journey of faith" for youth and their parents, who are in the sacramental formation process. It is a sign to the larger community that all of us have a role in the formation of anyone in the parish. Likewise, it shows youth and their families that they are part of the larger faith community. The members of the parish community provide prayer and support which is needed for the children, their families, and their religion teachers and catechists throughout the formation period. Parishioners are invited to pick-up a 2022 Confirmation prayer card from the basket in the vestibule area of the church.


