



#### Care Of The Sick:



### FROM THE CATECHISM OF THE CATHOLIC CHURCH

What is the Feast of the BAPTISM OF THE LORD?

Today we celebrate the Feast of the Baptism of the Lord. Many of us might be wondering why Jesus, who was sinless, needed to be baptized. According to the Catechism of the Catholic Church, "Our Lord voluntarily submitted himself to the baptism of St. John, intended for sinners, in order to 'fulfill all righteousness.'

THE SACRAMENT OF CHRISTIAN INITIATION - THE SACRAMENT OF BAPTISM

Holy Baptism is the basis of the whole Christian life, the gateway to life in the Spirit (vitae spiritualis ianua), and the door which gives access to the other sacraments. Through Baptism we are freed from sin and reborn as sons of God; we become members of Christ, are incorporated into the Church and made sharers in her mission: "Baptism is the sacrament of regeneration through water in the word."
