What do Catholics believe in? Catholics are, first and foremost, Christians who believe that **Jesus Christ is the Son of God**. ... The existence of the Holy Trinity — one God in three persons. Catholics embrace the belief that God, the one Supreme Being, is made up of three persons: God the Father, God the Son, and God the Holy Spirit.

Last week's answer: We can always resist temptations, because no temptation can force us into sin, and because God will always help us if we ask Him.

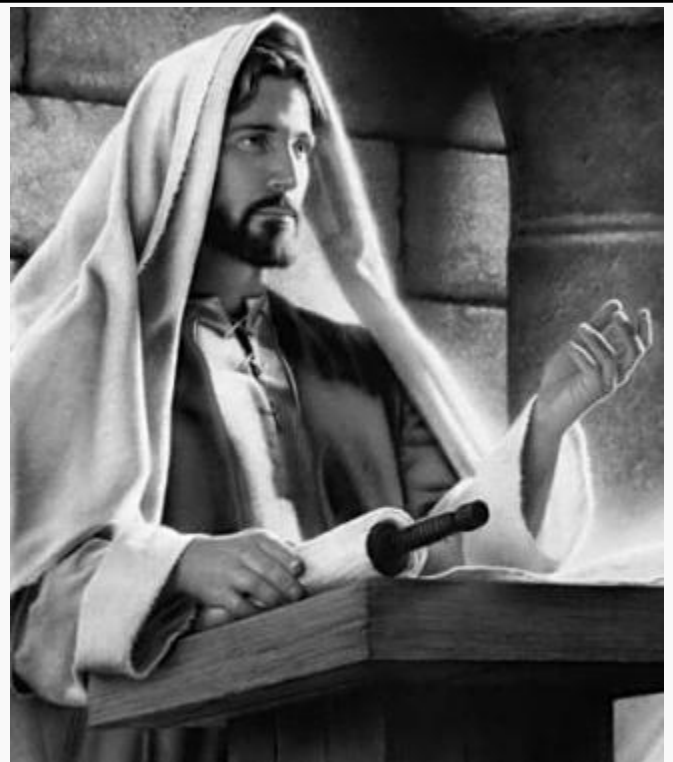
