

## SECOND SUNDAY OF LENT



Journey to the Foot of the Cross - Things to Remember for Lent

Remember the formula. The Church does a good job capturing certain truths with easy-to-remember lists and formulas: 10 Commandments, 7 sacraments, 3 persons in the Trinity. For Lent, the Church gives us almost a slogan—Prayer, Fasting and Almsgiving—as the three things we need to work on during the season.

It's a time of **prayer** spread out over 40 days. As we **pray**, we go on a journey, one that hopefully brings us closer to **Christ** and leaves us changed by the encounter with him and it is time to **fast**. With the fasts of Ash Wednesday and Good Friday, meatless Fridays, and our personal disciplines interspersed, Lent is the only time many Catholics these days actually **fast**. "What are you giving up for Lent? Hotdogs? Beer? Jelly beans?" It's almost a game for some of us, but **fasting** is actually a form of **penance**, which helps us turn away from sin and toward **Christ**.

*Let us pray:* O gracious Master, infuse in our hearts the spotless light of Your Divine Wisdom and open the eyes of our mind that we may understand the teachings of Your Gospel. Instill in us also the fear of Your blessed commandments, so that having curbed all carnal desires, we may lead a spiritual life, both thinking and doing everything to please You. For You, O Christ, our God, are the enlightenment of our souls and bodies; and to You we render glory, together with Your eternal Father, and with Your all holy, life-creating Spirit, now and ever, and forever. Amen.


The Marks and Attributes of the Church:
