

The Catechism of the Catholic Church on Lent: The season of Lent is mentioned in the Catechism of the Catholic Church in various sections and by the solemn forty days of Lent, the Church unites herself each year to the mystery of Jesus in the desert . . .

"... the Church, especially during Advent and Lent and above all at the Easter Vigil, re-reads and re-lives the great events of salvation history in the 'today' of her liturgy. But this also demands that catechesis help the faithful to open themselves to this spiritual understanding of the economy of salvation as the Church's liturgy reveals it and enables us to live it." "The seasons and days of penance in the course of the liturgical year (Lent, and each Friday in memory of the death of the Lord) are intense moments of the Church's penitential practice."

THIRD SUNDAY OF LENT



Journey to the Foot of the Cross Things to Remember for Lent

Remember the formula. 10 Commandments, 7 sacraments, 3 persons in the Trinity. For Lent, the Church gives us almost a slogan—Prayer, Fasting and Almsgiving—as the three things we need to work on during the season

- Lent is a time to work on discipline. The **40 days of Lent** are also a good, set time to work on personal discipline in general. Instead of giving something up, it can be doing something positive. I'm going to pray more, go to weekday Mass, attend the Stations of the Cross, or I'm going to be nicer to my family, friends and coworkers and the new person sitting next to me at Sunday Mass.
- It's tempting to make Lent some ambitious period of personal reinvention, but it's best to keep it simple and focused. There's a reason the Church works on these mysteries year after year. We spend our entire lives growing closer to God. Don't try to cram it all in one Lent. That's a recipe for failure.

Let us pray: Loving God, I hear your invitation, "Come back to me" and I am filled with such a longing to return to you.

Show me the way to return. Lead me this day in good works I do in your name and send your Spirit to guide me and strengthen my faith. I ask only to feel your love in my life today. Amen.
