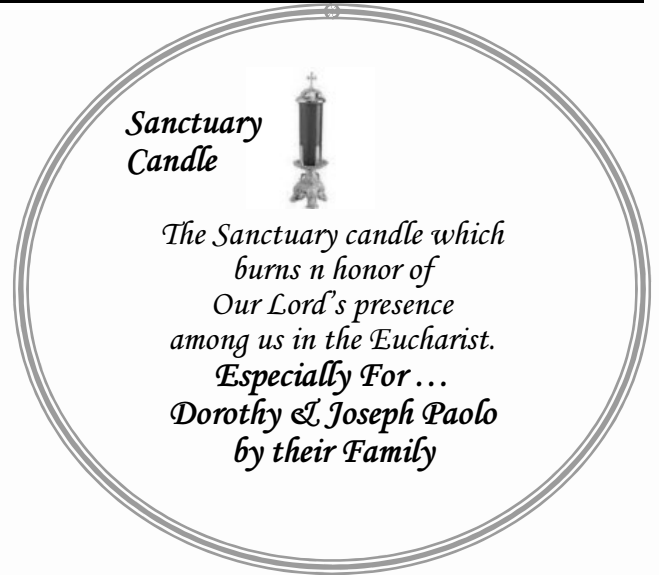

Regina caeli Message prepared for Divine Mercy Sunday, April 3, 2005
Notes and Quotes for Reflection on Divine Mercy

- From Creation, God has revealed his nature as love itself, in Sacred Scripture and most perfectly in the life, Passion, death and Resurrection of his .Son, Jesus. Saints have also borne witness to God's unfathomable love, e.g., in the writings of Augustine, Aquinas, Catherine of Siena, Francis of Assisi, Margaret Mary Alacoque and Thérèse of Lisieux
- In his second encyclical, **Rich in Mercy**, Pope Saint John Paul II offers an extended meditation on the mystery of God's mercy, which he calls "the greatest of the attributes and perfections of God" (*Dives in misericordia*, 13). He returned to this theme throughout his pontificate:

*As a gift to humanity, which sometimes seems bewildered and overwhelmed by the power of evil, selfishness, and fear, the Risen Lord offers His love that pardons, reconciles, and reopens hearts to love. It is a love that converts hearts and gives peace. **How much the world needs to understand and accept Divine Mercy!** Lord, who reveals the Father's love by Your death and Resurrection, we believe in You and confidently repeat to You today: **Jesus, I trust in You, have mercy upon us and upon the whole world.***

DIVINE MERCY SUNDAY



Divine Mercy Sunday: In 1935, an angel appeared to St. Faustina, and she heard the call to pray for mercy. The next day, Christ appeared and urged her to pray the Chaplet herself and with others at the hour of death. —*St. Faustina's Diary*

The Chaplet is Prayed on a five-decade Rosary:

1. Make the Sign of the Cross *In the name of the Father, and of the Son, and of the Holy Spirit. Amen.* **2. Recite the Our Father,** **3. Recite the Hail Mary.** **4. Recite the Apostle's Creed,** **5. The Eternal Father:** *Eternal Father, I offer you the Body and Blood, Soul and Divinity of Your Dearly Beloved Son, Our Lord, Jesus Christ, in atonement for our sins and those of the whole world.* **6. On the Ten Small Beads of Each Decade:** *For the sake of His sorrowful Passion, have mercy on us and on the whole world.* **7. Repeat for the remaining decades:** Saying the "Eternal Father" (5) on the "Our Father" bead and then 10 "For the sake of His sorrowful Passion" (6) on the following "Hail Mary" beads. **8. Conclude with Holy God** (Repeat three times) *Holy God, Holy Mighty One, Holy Immortal One, have mercy on us and on the whole world.*
