

Salazar Christ instituted the sacraments of the new law. There are seven: Baptism, Confirmation (or Chrismation), the Eucharist, Penance, the Anointing of the Sick, Holy Orders and 12 holes los Matrimony. the seven sacraments touch all the stages and Holy Mackerel! all the important moments of Christian life: they give birth and increase, healing and mission to the Christian's life of and some

faith. There is thus a certain resemblance between the stages of natural life and the stages of the spiritual life.

The sacraments of Christian initiation - **Baptism, Confirmation, and the Eucharist** - lay the foundations of every Christian life. "The sharing in the divine nature given to men through the grace of Christ bears a certain likeness to the origin, development, and nourishing of natural life. the faithful are born anew by **Baptism**, strengthened by the sacrament of **Confirmation**, and receive in the **Eucharist** the food of eternal life. By means of these sacraments of Christian initiation, they thus receive in *increasing* measure the treasures of the divine life and advance toward the perfection of charity.



May 3 – Feast Day of Sts. James & Philip - Apostles



• According to the *Gospel of John*, **Philip** was called by Jesus the day after he called Peter and Andrew and he responded immediately, believing Jesus to be the Messiah.

• After the Ascension of Jesus, **James** served as the head of the Church in Jerusalem and supported Saint Peter's decision regarding Gentile converts and the observance of Jewish laws, and is called the "brother of the Lord" (Mark 15:40).
