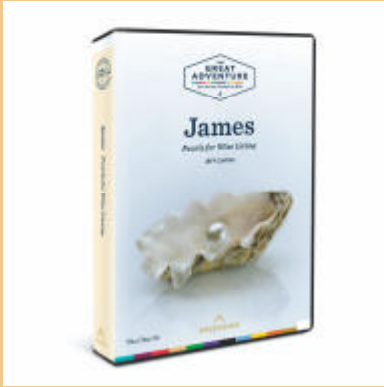
The Grand Annual letter has recently been mailed out. Thank you to all those families who have already donated to this year's Grand Annual Appeal.

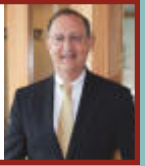

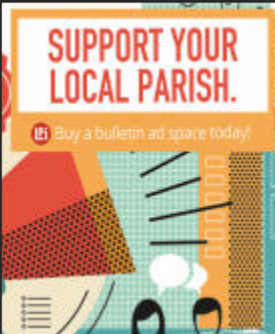
