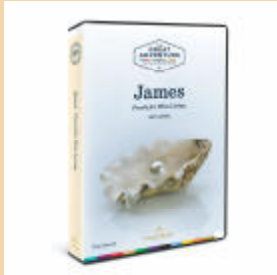
### **GRANDMOTHERS' GATHERING**

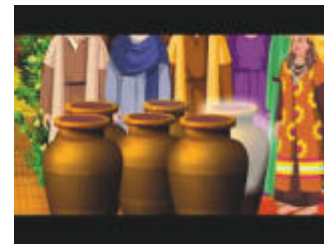
We are excited to announce that on Monday, January 31, 2022, we will be changing our format from Zoom to in person meetings.

Today we hear the story of the first miracle. A miracle is a sign of God's power and glory. It is a remarkable and amazing event that cannot be explained. 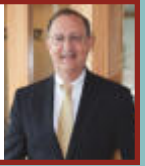

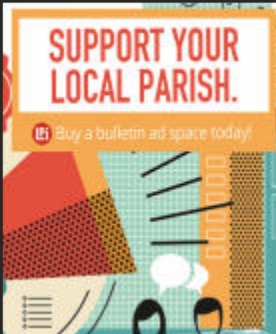
