

PARISH COUNSELING NETWORK- Catholic Charities of Orange, Sullivan and Ulster Counties offers a program called the "Parish Counseling Network"

which offers the people in our parishes access to short-term professional counseling at a nominal cost. This program connects people to more than 120 licensed mental health professionals to help them with issues and crises, including marital problems, parenting, eldercare, job loss and bereavement.

Those who would like to take advantage of this program must get in touch with the staff at their parish and the staff will let the Parish Counseling Network know that the parishioner will be getting in touch with them. The parishioner then gets in touch with the Network at 866- 962- 7487 to begin the process of finding a counselor. Parishioners are eligible for a maximum of six counseling sessions. The fee for each session is a \$10 co-pay. We can't speak for other parishes, but if that parishioner is a member of St. Joseph's and they would have a hard time paying those co-pays, the parish could help them with that.



RITE OF CHRISTIAN INITIATION FOR ADULTS (RCIA)- The Rite of Christian Initiation for Adults (RCIA) is the process that guides adults who want to enter the Catholic Church, and also for those who are already baptized but would like to receive the other sacraments of initiation- Eucharist and Confirmation.

And it can be even more- there's so much to learn about our faith, so much to explore about what that faith means for our everyday lives and our relationships and our place in the world, that we really never stop growing in our faith- or at least we shouldn't stop growing. The understanding we had as a child of God and the Church and spirituality is not enough- we all need to keep discovering the riches of our faith- and the RCIA program can help you to do that.

So RCIA can also be a way for Catholics who already have their sacraments to explore their faith and deepen their understanding of God's relationship to us. If you or someone you know would like to take advantage of this wonderful program, or are just curious about it, please see Fr. Salvatore or Fr. John Koelle. Classes begin in September and are held every week until April. And we have RCIA programs for children and teenagers as well- please see Sr. Philomena or Roberta Perrego for more information, or just contact the parish office and we'll point you in the right direction.
