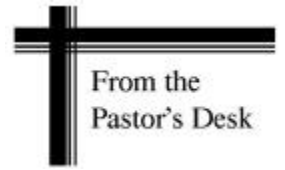

The Peace of the Lord be with you!

Last Sunday we celebrated the Solemnity of The Most Holy Body and Blood of Christ (Corpus Christi). This is a very special and important spiritual occasion.



The Eucharist is both a sacrifice and a sacrament. Jesus gave us the Holy Eucharist as our spiritual food on Holy Thursday.

The seven sacraments are God's gifts to us. The sacraments are visible signs that give us God's grace. All of the sacraments confer the power and goodness of Jesus.

The Eucharist is special. The Eucharist is Jesus Himself. When we receive Holy Communion we are receiving Jesus. Our bodies and Jesus Body unite each time we receive Holy Communion.

This is a sacred encounter. The Eucharist nourishes our soul. The Eucharist leads us to eternal life. The Real Presence of Jesus is an essential dogma of our faith. Jesus is present Body, Blood, Soul and Divinity in the Eucharist.

The Eucharist is a sacrifice. Each mass is a re-enactment of the sacrifice of Jesus on Calvary on Good Friday. He died for us.

Let us cherish each reception of Holy Communion as a sacred encounter with Jesus. When we receive Holy Communion, we become a living tabernacle for Jesus.

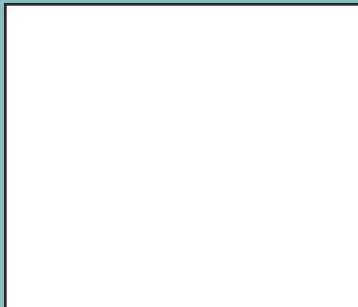
