Bible Study Group – 1st & 3rd Wednesday of the month in the Parish Center. (Sept.-June)

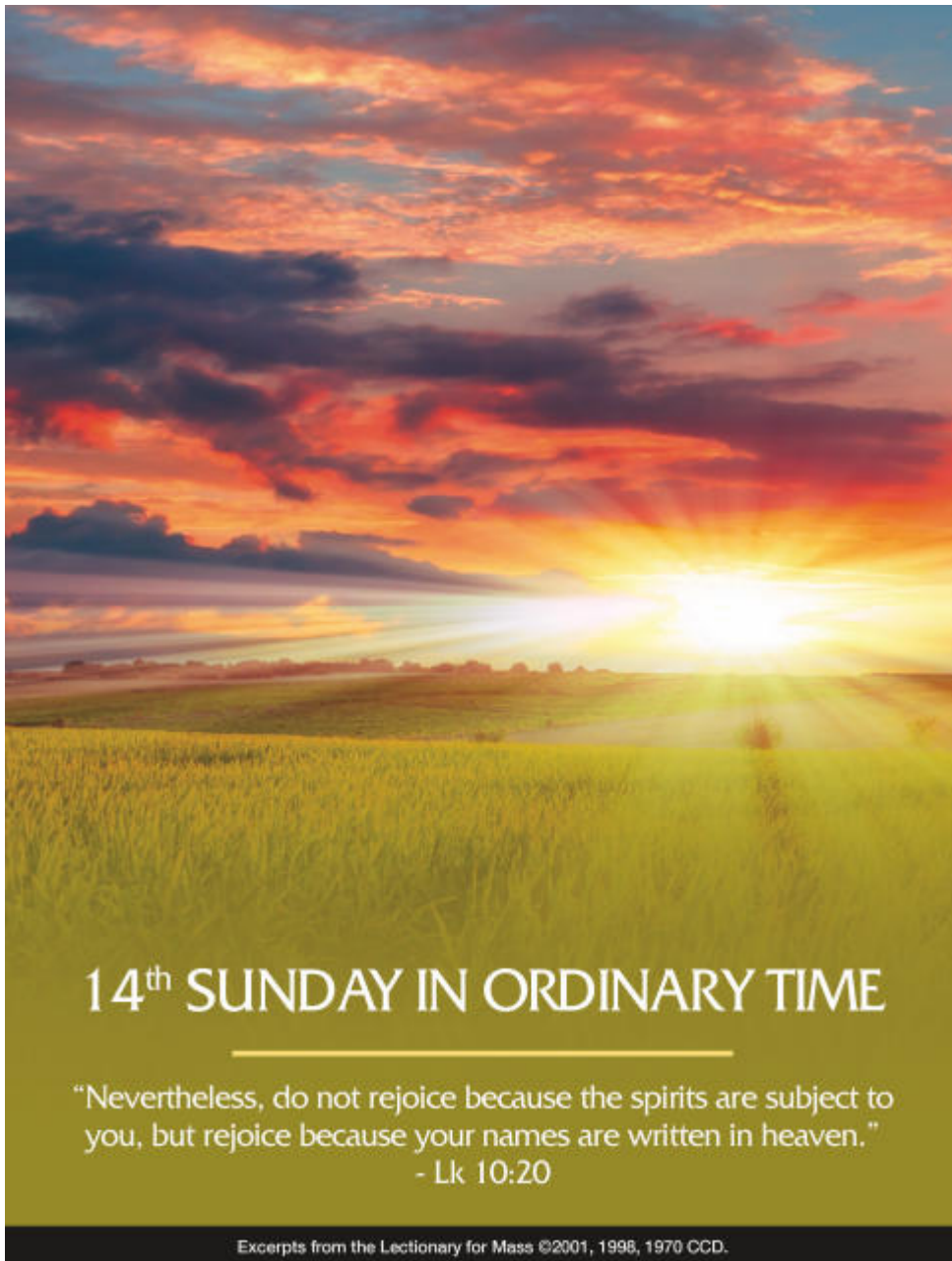
Men's Fellowship Group—2nd Saturday of each month at 9 a.m. in the TMR.

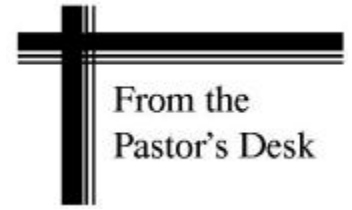

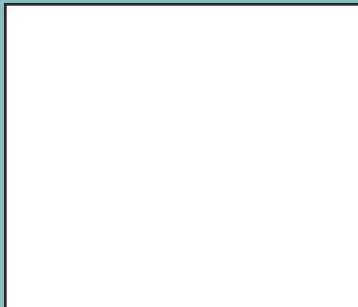
