**From the  
Pastor's Desk**



**Dear Parishioners,**

Recently I read an article written by a laywoman who has spent several years as a pastoral associate in a parish. She has four grown children, three of whom no longer practice the faith. She wrote about their reasons. Expectedly, one of the factors was the lack of trust in Church leadership because of the sexual abuse crisis. But, that wasn't the number one reason. Apparently they expressed the fact that they had felt that they were spoon-fed religion from the time they were young and expected to attend Mass and receive the Sacraments whether or not they personally believed what they were being taught. As they grew older they realized that they had not internalized what they had been taught. This woman is not alone in having children who no longer believe what she believes. They have become part of the "nones" who are a growing number of people who don't practice any religion and who often have no faith in God.

I sometimes wonder if so many in recent generations have become "nones" because they see no need for God and may actually see themselves as gods. It's understandable in the culture in which we live with all of the advances in technology and the sciences which give people the impression that they are pretty much in control of the world in which they live. After all, if you live in a country where your tax-funded space program can, after an eight month journey, land an apparatus on another planet and then launch a drone to explore miles of alien terrain, you might well think that you and your fellow human beings might be pretty much like gods yourselves. With such great accomplishments we may easily forget our limitations especially in the area of human relationships which is witnessed by the violence and war still so present on the face of the earth.

This weekend's Feast of the Trinity reminds us that there is indeed a God who is beyond but also very close to us. The very real, accessible and feeling human being, Jesus of Nazareth, revealed himself to those who knew him as this God in the flesh and he revealed to us the loving Father who created us all and the Holy Spirit that inspires and guides us. May this weekend by an opportunity for us to reconnect with this loving God who not only brought us into being but who gives us purpose in life.



**THOUGHTS FROM A TRUSTEE:**


*Dear Parishioners,*
