From the Pastor's Desk



Dear Parishioners,

Earlier this morning I heard on the news that two suspects had been arrested in the shooting of the 6-year-old boy who was sitting in his car seat in the back of his mother's vehicle. It seems that the whole thing had been initiated by a road rage incident when the suspect driver had cut off the mother who, in turn, responded with an unfriendly gesture. The suspect then maneuvered so as to follow the mother and then shot into the car. What a horrible turn of events, due to an act of over the top anger and revenge over a silly little every day occurrence. As a result, a beautiful young life was cut short and the lives of his family and of the suspects are irreparably altered.

It seems that everyday we are hearing of more and more events of anger and outrage leading to horrific violence, all because people can't tolerate being ignored or put in second place. They want to be in control and envy those who seem to get the upper hand in one way or another. What is needed is a new appreciation for the virtues of humility and temperance. We all need to remind ourselves that we are not number 1 in this world. There are others whom we must learn to cooperate with. We also need to learn not to expect to have everything we want the way we want. There are others who must be accommodated as well. We need to relearn the self-discipline and self-sacrifice that many of us learned many years ago when we were children.

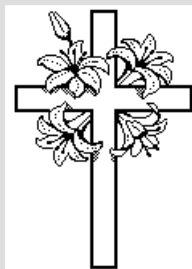
