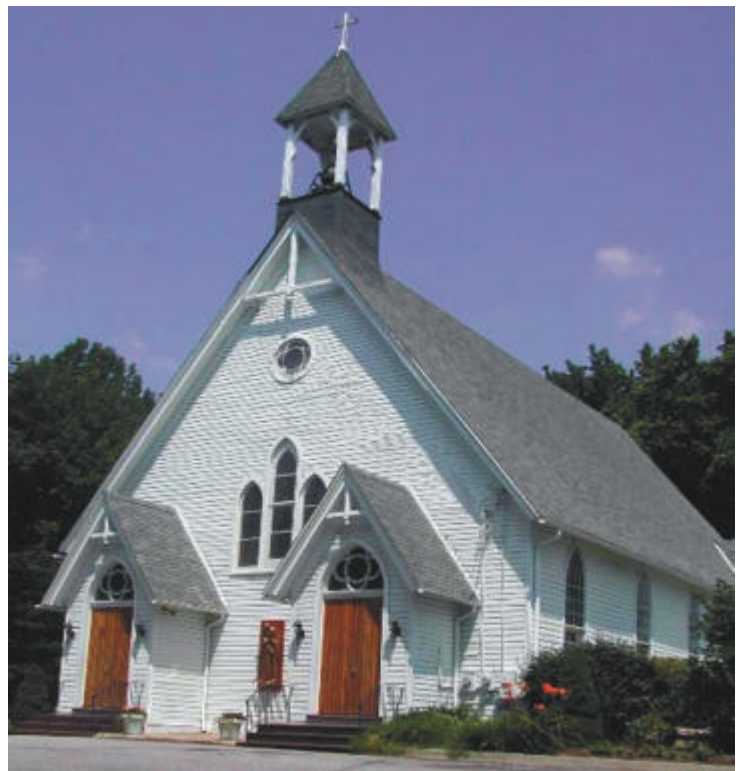

Collect Prayer for the First Sunday of Lent – “Grant, almighty God, through the yearly observances of holy Lent, that we may grow in understanding of the riches hidden in Christ and by worthy conduct pursue their effects. Through our Lord Jesus Christ, your Son, who lives and reigns with you in the unity of the Holy Spirit, one God, for ever and ever.” The cyclical pattern of the liturgical year is geared toward our continuing religious formation. Our conduct of obedience and charity makes us a fertile ground for spiritual growth. The treasures of Christ are largely hidden but real—we see this in the mysteries of faith (sacraments) and in the gift of grace. The effects are growth in holiness, evermore taking on the likeness of Christ.
