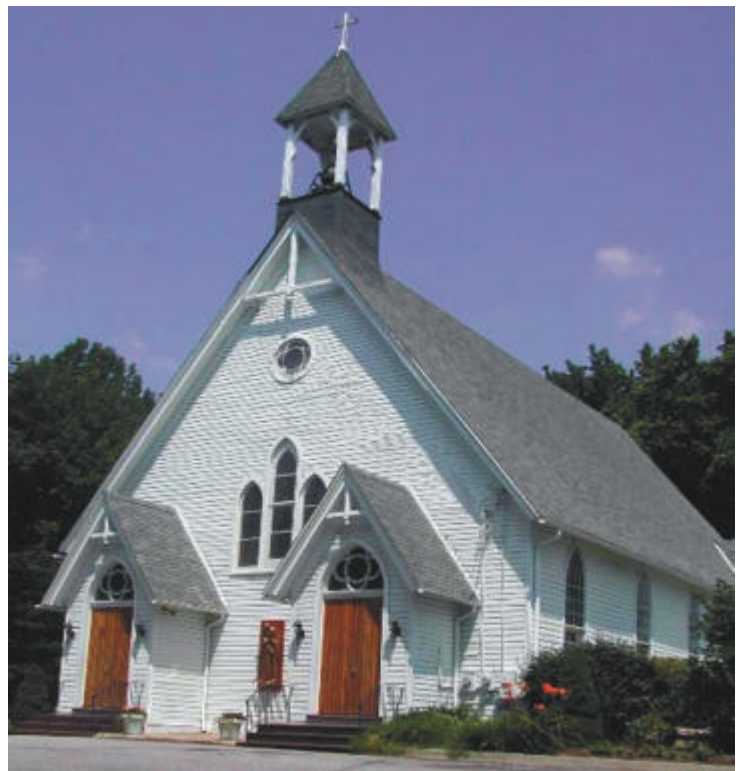

The Penitential Season of Lent is Upon Us!

Stations of the Cross will be held on Friday, April 12 at 7:30 PM. On Good Friday, April 19, Stations of the Cross will be at 3:00 PM. We invite you to join fellow parishioners in this beautiful Lenten devotion.

“The Light is on for You” - This Lent take the opportunity to receive Christ's mercy in the Sacrament of Reconciliation. It will be available every Wednesday evening during Lent from 6:30 to 7:30 PM and every Saturday from 4:30 to 5:00 PM.

Outdoor Easter Crosses – The life size crosses that are used for Good Friday Stations will become our Easter Crosses with your help. Each year parishioners are invited to select one of the fourteen and decorate them on Holy Saturday. These Easter Crosses will be displayed for several weeks after Easter. When you sign up, please remember the following:

- Crosses are decorated on Saturday, April 20 and should be done by 4:30 PM.
- You are responsible for removing all decorations when it is time to take them down.
