In honor of those who died in the name of peace and all of our departed loved ones, we will celebrate Mass on Memorial Day, May 27 at 9:00 AM in the Church. Immediately following the Mass we will have a procession to the cemetery grounds for a prayer, the blessing of graves and a general remembrance of those who have died.
