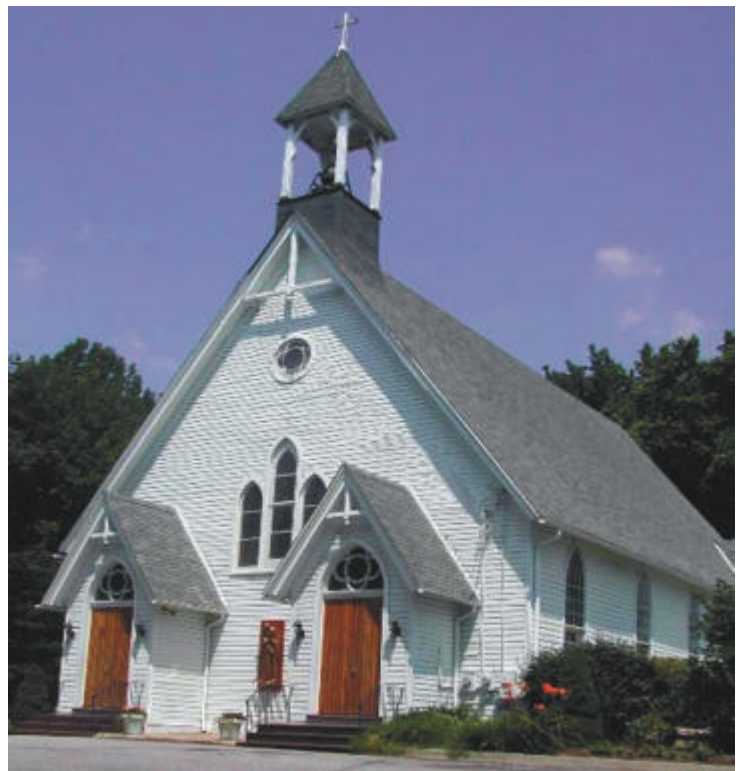

Just as we celebrated the Stations of the Cross during Lent, here we will observe fourteen stations which express the Easter mystery.
