

TOWN HALLS

Thank you to all who attended the Town Halls. We will be offering a few more, so that everyone has the opportunity to attend; it is my hope that every parishioner and friend of Saint J's would be present for a Town Hall meeting in person. It would be such a gift to me to see you there this weekend or next weekend as we contemplate the heart of our Mission. It is only right and good that I do that with you; the people who make our Mission possible.

HIGH LEVEL OVERVIEW OF TOWN HALL

The Mission of Saint J's is bearing fruit

for the Kingdom of God by touching lives (the poor, the widow, the orphan, the senior, the young), proclaiming the Gospel, making disciples and bringing JOY to Quincy and beyond:

- ♦ 197 registered volunteers
- ♦ 28+ teens attending weekly youth group with Eucharistic Adoration
- ♦ 60+ Seniors attend our Senior Luncheons
- ♦ 89,440 views for our Livestream Holy Hours and Masses
- ♦ And so much more..
- The State of Affairs as of Advent 2022. The First Quarter results showed increasing expenses, declining
 offertory and a widening gap between expenses and revenue. As a result, both parishes had an operating
 loss of more than \$20,000.
- Next Steps: Walking By Faith. We live in dark economic times and the Season of Advent moves us from the darkness to THE LIGHT. His Name is Jesus. God has worked miracles in the past. The answer is more than money: it is J.O.Y. (Jesus. Others. Yourself.). When everyone gifts of their time, talent and treasure, the Gospel is shared, our community prospers, and we spread JOY to the world.
- **Time** is about your relationship with Jesus and fellowship in the Lord;
- Talent is about giving the gifts and talents Jesus has blessed you with to others;
- Treasure is about giving back to the Lord from the financial blessings He has bestowed upon you.

Advent is a period of JOYful Preparation for the Nativity of the Lord Jesus. It is also a time for us to examine our Stewardship of Time, Talent and Treasure with the Holy Spirit, in order to make a special gift and commitment to the Lord, renewing our stewardship for this New Year. In the weeks to come we will feature a commitment card that each parishioner is asked to complete in order to help ensure Saint J's community prospers and continues to spread JOY to the world! The Commitment cards can be submitted at any time during Advent (Season of JOYful Preparation), with a closing date of January 1, 2023.



parish, and we wanted to serve and use our talents in some way. Fr. Matt asked us to be part of the RCIA program, which we have been part of for the last two years. It has been such a blessed ministry to be part of and help people grow in their faith. It has been a blessing to walk with these candidates on their journey to be Catholic and has increased our faith! It has also increased our faith and taught us more about our faith. Mary, who is far more reserved than I, also felt a calling to be a Eucharistic minister. The church provided her training and now she has the honor to distribute Jesus to fellow parishioners as needed.

This all coincided with the implementation of the joy movement, and the timing could not have been more perfect! We love the concept of serving Jesus, others, and then, ourselves! This is something we wanted to be part of as a family! When the church began online, giving, something we have never done before, Mary and I prayed about this. We always tried to give more than we thought we should and prided ourselves in giving more than the one or two dollars we gave 40 years ago. As far as our giving to the Church, I never gave much thought asking the Lord how much we should give! I have over the past decades, given a bit more every few years, but that is about it. I thought I was doing a rather good job. However, I ask God to put an amount on our heart and he did! I basically made the comment, I think you are making a mistake Lord or, there may be an extra zero on there! I did not begin online giving right away but did increase the amount I put in the weekly collection. However, God continued to put, this amount in my head for a weekly online contribution, and it just did not make sense to me! I retired from the US Postal Service three years ago and drive Uber during the day and Mary works during the day as well, so we work hard to stretch out our money. What The Lord was asking us to give in a week was more than what I gave

in a month. I know this though, God has always, always been faithful to me, Mary, and our five children and has always insured we have everything we need! We are giving more now to the church than we have ever given in our lives. it has been an absolute miracle to watch God continue to provide for our family. There have been several months over the past several years, when, balancing the checkbook, the math just does not add up! There is always more in the bank account than what the ledger says should be in there! For a time, this drove me, absolutely mad, because I could not find my mistake or where I forgot to add something in. I then realized; this is God's math! This is God's faithfulness to me and my family!

For years I had automatic withdrawals to put money in my 401(k) account. This was an investment to be used for me and my family's future and to provide for us. This is how I now think about online giving, and the automatic payments I have sent to St J's. I I look at it as a bill that I have an obligation to pay every week! This investment is an investment in kingdom work! The Lord is counting on my family, and I to use the time, talents, and treasures, to make Jesus known to our families, our community and to the world! Saint J's collaborative is a great steward of what is given to them! They serve, not only Quincy, but other South Shore communities through stewardship! It makes our church community stronger, and allows us to be Jesus to others, and bring people closer to him!

In the book of Malachi, chapter 3 verse 10, it says "bring the full ties into the store, house, that there may be food in my house; and thereby put me to the test, says the Lord of host, if I will not open the windows of heaven for you, and pour down for you and overflowing blessing"!

I do not know if God really wants us to test him, or if he is testing us. I know this, I want to pass that test, and I want to pass it with flying colors! I feel so favored by the Lord and how He has blessed me abundantly with an amazing wife, children, grandchild, friends, shelter, and food! I worried in the past that I did not have enough time to share my time with the church and having such a large family I did not have much money to spare! But I have found out that God controls it all! He invented time and money! He has always provided me with enough time and enough money for the things my family and I need! I'm working to ensure that my family and I gets to heaven, and take as many with us as we can, and hear the words that we all long to hear, well done, good and faithful servant!
