From the Pastor's Desk.

Can Catholics believe in Aliens?

A strange question it may seem, I'm sure. Yet it was reported in late December of last year that, back in 2016, NASA had gathered a group of theologians of different faiths to reflect on how the discovery of extraterrestrial life – i.e., alien life – would impact different faith systems.

The general consensus was that, different as the various faiths are, discovery of life on other planets wouldn't prove to be that much of a challenge to what is already believed.

The website Futurist.com further reports:

"The headline findings are that adherents of a range of religious traditions report that they can take the idea in their stride," Rev. Dr. Andrew Davison, an Anglican priest and theologian at University of Cambridge who took part in the program, said in a new book about the initiative titled "Astrobiology and Christian Doctrine."

Davison added that the non-religious community at large tends to "overestimate the challenges that religious people" would encounter if we ever discovered evidence of alien life.

If you went to Fr. Robert Spitzer's talk a couple of months ago, you would have heard him give a similar reply. In an article on the subject he said,

First, it is possible that non-intelligent alien life exists in the universe... given the fact that there are a billion trillion stars with almost as many exoplanets within the habitable zone of those stars.

This does not imply anything about God's creation, the human soul, or God's salvific intention. It merely shows the heights and breadth of His imagination and creative power.

So what does the Church say about life on other planets? It may exist – we have to leave that discovery up to scientists. If and when extraterrestrial life is found, it makes no difference to our faith. Fr. Spitzer can finish this column better than I can:

I would assume that if aliens really existed, and they were like us -- having self-reflectivity, freedom of choice, moral reasoning, a capacity for empathy and love, and an awareness of the transcendent and spiritual, then they probably have souls (just like our souls). If they do have souls, and have the capacity for freedom, moral reasoning, love and empathy, and a transcendent and spiritual life, then we must assume that they can choose either good or evil, and even a life that is oriented toward good (God) or evil (just like we can). If this is the case, then we should not be shunning them, but instead trying to evangelize them.
