From the Pastor's Desk.

Remembering the Promises of Baptism

I thought it would be good to begin Masses last week with the sprinkling of holy water as a reminder of our own Baptisms as we celebrated the Feast of the Baptism of the Lord. For most of us, receiving Baptism is something we can't remember: if we're lucky, we have photos or videos of the occasion. For those of you who are parents — and family members and friends — of children who have been baptized, you were able to witness the celebration of the sacrament second-hand. However, all of us who are Christian can look back to that moment in our lives when we were cleansed of original sin and filled with sanctifying grace, becoming a child of God through adoption.

One of the key moments of the ritual of Baptism are the promises. I invite to reflect on the following:

Celebrant: Do you reject Satan? And all his works? And all his empty show?

Parents and Godparents: I do.

Another option for this section of questions:

Celebrant: Do you reject sin, so as to live in the freedom of God's children? Do you reject the glamor of evil, and refuse to be mastered by sin? Do you reject Satan, father of sin and prince of darkness?

Parents and Godparents: I do.

Following this, the priest or deacon asks for an affirmation of faith:

Celebrant: Do you believe in God, the Father almighty, creator of heaven and earth? Do you believe in Jesus Christ, his only Son, our Lord, who was born of the Virgin Mary, was crucified, died, and was buried, rose from the dead, and is now seated at the right hand of the Father? Do you believe in the Holy Spirit, the holy catholic Church, the Communion of saints, the forgiveness of sins, the resurrection of the body, and life everlasting?

Parents and Godparents: I do.

Most of us cannot remember these questions from our baptisms: our parents and godparents answered on our behalf as they committed to raising us with faith in Jesus Christ. Now that we are older, it can be good to look at these promises from time to time and to reflect on the conviction with which we are living them – obviously, seeking to avoid sin, but more importantly, seeking even more to let our faith in Jesus Christ shine through every action of our life.


