ST. PATRICK

St. Patrick | March 17

Whether you know him as the man who brought Christianity to Ireland or simply as a reason you eat corned beef and cabbage in March, St. Patrick (415 - 493) is a well-known saint around the world.

St. Patrick was born in Britain of a Romanized family. At the age of 16, he was kidnapped by Irish raiders from the villa of his father, a deacon and local official, and brought into slavery in Ireland. He spent six long years there as a herdsman, during which he turned to his faith for

strength. He later escaped back to Britain on a ship, where he was eventually reunited with his family. His years of captivity changed him and brought out a


zeal for God and a yearning to spread the message of Jesus Christ. Despite the constant danger of martyrdom, he continued to travel throughout Ireland where he baptized and confirmed in the name of Christ.

They have no wine -

Jesus' first miracle during his three-year ministry preceding His death on the cross was done at the indication of His Mother. She did not even have to ask Him. She simply highlighted the need and then taught them to do what Jesus says.

The Wedding at Cana. John 2:1-11

* On the third day there was a wedding* in Cana* in Galilee, and the mother of Jesus was there.

Jesus and his disciples were also invited to the wedding.
When the wine ran short, the mother of Jesus said to him, "They have no wine."

* [And] Jesus said to her, "Woman, how does your concern affect me? My hour has not yet come."

His mother said to the servers, "Do whatever he tells you."

* Now there were six stone water jars there for Jewish ceremonial washings, each holding twenty to thirty gallons.

Jesus told them, "Fill the jars with water." So they filled them to the brim.

Then he told them, "Draw some out now and take it to the headwaiter."* So they took it.

And when the headwaiter tasted the water that had become wine, without knowing where it came from (although the servers who had drawn the water knew), the head waiter called the bridegroom

and said to him, "Everyone serves good wine first, and then when people have drunk freely, an inferior one; but you have kept the good wine until now." Jesus did this as the beginning of his signs* in Cana in Galilee and so revealed his glory, and his disciples began to believe in him. Since the beginning, Our Lady - the Blessed Mother of Jesus, and our Mother, has always listened to God's will. And when we bring our needs to her, all she has to do is present the need. All we need to do is what He tells us.

Some may read the Gospel passage of the wedding at Cana and think that there was no purpose to that miracle. That the wine, running out was not worth a prayer or a miracle. But there are no prayers too small for our Mother. There are also no prayers too big.

"There is no problem, I tell you, no matter how difficult it is, that we cannot resolve by the prayer of the Holy Rosary." -Sister Lucia dos Santos of Fatima

The Rosary is the gift that Our Mother in heaven gives us. We pray with her when we pray the Rosary and she presents all of it to Jesus. But maybe you don't know how to pray the Rosary. St. Junipero Serra Parish invites you along with one of our parishioners, Allison, to learn to pray the Rosary. All are invited regardless of your background or experience, the only requirement is to bring your heart to your Mother in heaven so that she can present your prayers to Jesus. 
