



*Don't be afraid to clean, even if all you have are your hands.* My mother's words often replay in my mind, when I come upon a toothpaste-filled sink or crumbs on the kitchen floor. I can see her hands under the white foamed warm water, as mine now mirror hers, making do without proper tools, and only simple hands.

I think oftentimes, it is easy to get overwhelmed by not having the proper tools and abilities. We can convince ourselves that sure, *someone must speak up for the unborn, but what could I say? Or sure someone should evangelize, but how would I do that?* The

truth is, if we begin all of our work with prayer, knowing that all good comes from God and that we are His instruments. If we look at it like that, we can be like Saint Bernadette - of Lourdes who said, *"My job is to inform, not to convince."* Mother Teresa said, *"There are many people who can do big things, but there are very few people who will do the small things.*" It has been my experience in life, that those very small things are the very big things that move hearts. As my husband often likes to quote, *"Everyone wants to change the world, but no one wants to change the toilet paper roll.*" It's comical because if you cannot be bothered by those little things, you can end up missing the point completely. Maybe every morning we could ask ourselves, *what is the smallest thing that I can do today?*


