



### PREPARE FOR AND CELEBRATE DIVINE MERCY SUNDAY APRIL 24, 2022



All are invited to St. Francis Church to pray the Novena and Chaplet this Easter Season.

The 9 day Divine Mercy Novena and Chaplet begins on **Good Friday, April 15, 2022 and concludes on Divine Mercy Sunday, April 24, 2022** at 3pm with adoration, chaplet and benediction.

This prayer was revealed by our Lord to St. Maria Faustina Kowalska, a Polish nun, on Good Friday 1937. Our Lord commanded St. Faustina "to make a 9 day novena, before the Feast of Mercy [now known as Divine Mercy Sunday] for the conversion of the whole world and for the restoration of The Divine Mercy". Our Lord told her that "by reciting this novena, I will grant every possible grace to souls". All you need for the novena is your rosary. The prayer book of the Chaplet will be provided.

Our Lord also stated "I desire the Feast of Mercy be a refuge and shelter for all souls and especially for poor sinners. On that day [Divine Mercy Sunday] the

very depths of my tender mercy are open. I pour out a whole ocean of graces upon those souls who approach the fount of my mercy". Also, "The soul that will go to Confession\* and receive Holy Communion [on Divine Mercy Sunday] shall obtain complete forgiveness of sins and punishment". (Diary 699). This promise is beyond that of a plenary indulgence which remits temporal punishment but not the remission of the sin.

The day/time for reciting the 9 day Novena and Chaplet of Divine Mercy are as follows:

Holy Saturday, April 16 at 3 PM
Easter Sunday, April 17 at 7 PM
Monday, April 18 at 6 PM
Tuesday, April 19 at 7PM
Wednesday, April 20 at 7 PM
Thursday, April 21 at 7 PM
Friday, April 22 at 6 PM
Saturday, April 23 at 3 PM
Divine Mercy Sunday, April 24 at 3pm

\*Note: Confession doesn't necessarily have to occur during the 9 day novena 4/15 to 4/23, however one should go to confession before Divine Mercy Sunday. Please come bring your family and friends to pray the Divine Mercy Novena to our Lord and to obtain the complete forgiveness of our sins and punishment as promised.



Though it was more than ten years ago, I can still see the grin spread across my son's face when he was about four years old.

THE WAY.

AND

THE TRUTH.

AND

THE LIFE.

NO ONE COMES

We were eating at a restaurant and his grandfather was explaining to him about SOUND SPACE - you could almost see four walls being built up in my son's mind, perimeters that could be filled or emptied, infringed upon, or defended.

That day his grandfather was teaching my son about voice volume, or as is commonly known as inside voice. He spoke of the area of space around my son, and how he was responsible to try and respect other people's sound space that was around each one of them. Again I could see as he pictured four walls being built up around each other person in the restaurant.

Sound space in the spiritual life though is more than just inside voice and outside voice. It includes a space that can be kept quiet even while all about you is noisy. Today even at the gas pump a television begins to play and music thumps from cars at every side. But still, we can prepare four walls in our hearts and minds, times and places, and a disposition for interior silence

Silence is a prerequisite for prayer and for hearing God's voice within us. The word *Space* brings to mind galaxies and rockets and planets and moons and when we cultivate this space within, the heavens and saints and angels, and God and our Blessed Mother, and those who have gone before us, are available to us in prayer.

CCC2717 Contemplative prayer is silence, the "symbol of the world to come" or "silent love." Words in this kind of prayer are not speeches; they are like kindling that feeds the fire of love. In this silence, unbearable to the "outer" man, the Father speaks to us his incarnate Word, who suffered, died, and rose; in this silence the Spirit of adoption enables us to share in the prayer of Jesus.

The other day I decided to drive without the radio on and I instinctually drove slower and I noticed things I did not usually notice, like the color of certain houses, fences, and people in the cars passing by me.

Nestling in silence against the heart of God, with the open Bible over our head like the wings of the Holy Spirit, is still the best antidote, the one thing necessary to chase away from our interior territory all that is useless, superfluous, worldly, and even our own self"


