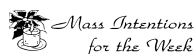

**The Lenten Experience**

**DAILY MASS** at 8:30 am Monday through Saturday followed by Rosary and Benediction (in the church) .

**ADORATION OF THE BLESSED SACRAMENT** is Monday through Friday after the 8:30 am Mass.

**STATIONS OF THE CROSS**— Fridays during Lent at 10:00 am and 7:00 pm. Stations on **Good Friday** are at **NOON**.

**FASTING AND ABSTINENCE IN LENT**

**Ash Wednesday** and **Good Friday** are days of fasting and abstinence which means a limit of one full meal on these days for all between the ages of 13 and 59. Meat is not to be consumed on Ash Wednesday and Fridays during Lent for those age 14 and older.

**WEEKDAYS OF LENT**

There is no obligation to fast. However, voluntary acts of self-denial are recommended.

**CONFESSIONS** are heard 1/2 hour before the Masses on the weekends; every Wednesday of Lent from 6:30 pm to 7:00 pm; or anytime by appointment.
