

**The Most Holy Trinity**




Let God be who God is. This is often one of the hardest things to do. Rather than allowing the mystery of being created in the image and likeness of God unfold and take root in our lives, we change the dynamic. We want to be the creators who want to make God into the image and likeness we need God to be. We have a hard-enough time letting the people in our lives be who they are. We struggle even more so with God. It is almost as if we want God to be our imaginary friend who is not only with us whenever we need but becomes the Being we need God to be. Who is it that we want God to be today? A protector, disciplinarian, champion for justice, healer, advocate for our cause, grantor of prayers, guardian of my life, or the avenger? Our prayers tell an interesting story. When you pray, what does God look like?

Recently, a young woman who was feeling invisible, overlooked, ignored, and misunderstood by her husband struggled to make her feelings known and get his attention.

Finally, she screamed, “Listen to me!” Thus, birth was given to a renewed and healthier relationship. We spend so much time storming heaven with our agenda and trying to make God into a “god” of our desires that we do not hear God saying, “Listen to me!” God is desperately trying to get our attention. God is saying, I am here among you as not one but three, Father, Son, and Holy Spirit. Many people seldom notice God’s presence because they are so caught up with other spiritual cares and concerns. And, when the “god” they fashion and create doesn’t produce as they desire, they shake the dust from their feet and move on. “I tried,” they exclaim, “but God didn’t listen.”

Healthy relationships aren’t built on making someone be who we need them to be. Healthy relationships are built on encounters of persons and the development of an appreciation of someone solely for who they are. Deeper relationships can even be found with two people marveling at each other and almost experiencing a childlike joy and giddiness when they see the other coming. Do you ever have these feelings about God? Believe it or not, God does for you! There is a joyful laughter that gives rise to and connects all three members of the Holy Trinity. It is this laughter, flowing from the very depths of the Godhead that not only keeps the Trinity in joyful unity but spills over into the creation of all beings and things. It is an expression of Divine Delight! Have you ever taken time away from your agenda to experience the Divine Joyfulness of God?

We can reach a connection of Presence wherein even the smallest of creatures suddenly radiate the fullness of God: the wonderful creation of their being, the innocence and playfulness of their movements, and the sustaining life breath that flows through their veins. The same God who created the heavens and the earth is the same God who wants you to call him ‘Dad’ and the same God who preserves your life and has all things in His care. ©LPi

### ***A PRAYER FOR OUR COUNTRY***


*O Most Blessed Virgin Mary*, Mother of Mercy, at this most critical time, we entrust the United States of America to your loving care.

Thank God-literally-that He doesn't take a break, even if we do. Can we try to remember that, even in the midst of our many wonderful distractions? Let's enjoy this summer. Let's live it to the full. But let's see it for the gift that it is- and remember the thanks we owe the Giver.

## NOTICE TO ALL VIRTUS TRAINED VOLUNTEERS

**SAFE ENVIRONMENT/VIRTUS TRAINING:** In the Diocese of Bridgeport, the Safe Environment program and victim assistance ministry has been in place since 2003 and the Diocese has shown great leadership in the areas of child abuse prevention, detection, early intervention, and outreach to survivors of sexual abuse.

In light of our sacred obligation to protect all of God's children, the Most Reverend Frank J. Caggiano, Bishop of Bridgeport, has issued updated guidelines and procedures for the 2020 Safe Environment Handbook. Safe Environment training and criminal background checks continue to be required of all clergy, employees, volunteers, tenants, vendors, and independent contractors in the Diocese of Bridgeport. These safeguards must be renewed every five or ten years based on a person's ministry. The Safe Environment Handbook is available online.

Earlier this year, Our Lady of Peace sent emails to volunteers whose email addresses we have on file. We asked that you visit the Diocese website ([www.bridgeportdiocese.org](http://www.bridgeportdiocese.org)) or Our Lady of Peace website ([www.ourladyofpeacestratfordct.weconnect.com](http://www.ourladyofpeacestratfordct.weconnect.com)) to read the revised Safe Environment Handbook 2020, print and sign a copy of the Executive Summary Sheet for Lay Volunteers (page 72) and return a signed copy to the Parish Office.

In addition, the Diocese sent notification to certain volunteers to update their Virtus account. To update your account, log on to [virtusonline.com](http://virtusonline.com), enter your User ID and Password and follow the prompts.

Many volunteers have complied; unfortunately, many of you have not.

This year the Office of Safe Environment, in full compliance with the U.S.C.C.B. Charter for the Protection of Children and Young People, is conducting a full audit of the Diocese of Bridgeport. Our Lady of Peace will be audited in the fall 2021. VIRTUS training, recertification, background checks, and Executive summary sheets are to be on file at the time of the audit.

**Volunteers not in compliance with Virtus by May 31st will no longer be able to volunteer. Volunteers are very important to our parish so please comply with all of the guidelines. For parishioners who can no longer volunteer please notify the Parish Office.**

For Virtus trained parishioners who do not have access to computers, please call the Parish Office 203-377-4863 ext 10 and leave a message for Maryann our Virtus Coordinator and she will return your call.

Thank you for your cooperation and understanding.


