

Dear Our Lady of Victory Parish Family,

I hope that you all had a blessed Christmas day with friends and loved ones and that your 2022 is off to a good start.

This weekend we celebrate the Feast of the Epiphany. In the visit of the Magi to the Christ child, the Lord tells us that Jesus has come to be present to all of his people, both Jewish and Gentile. It is customary on Epiphany to chalk the doorway to our households. If you would like to do this in your home, take a piece of chalk and write on the outside of your house or inside above the front main entrance (above or next to an entrance) +20 C M B 22+. The letters C M B come from the traditional names for the three kings: Caspar, Melchior, and Balthazar. It is also an abbreviation for *Christus Mansionem Benedicat* which means, "May Christ bless this dwelling!" The first and last numbers simply refer to the current year.


After making the inscription in chalk, pray: "Lord God of heaven and earth, you revealed your only begotten Son to every nation by the guidance of a star. Bless this house and all who live here and all who visit. May we be blessed with health, kindness of heart, gentleness and the keeping of your law. Fill us with the light of Christ, that our love for each other may go out to all. We ask this through Christ our Lord. Amen."

This weekend, please welcome Fr. Farrell McLaughlin, a visiting priest who comes to us from Cross Catholic Outreach. Fr. McLaughlin was ordained for the diocese of Providence, RI in 1971.
