



BUSINESS MANAGER'S BLOG

Hi All,

At a recent meeting of the Finance Committee, a suggestion was made that I should put out a Business Manager's Blog on a more regular basis. Most of you know that I always have something to say, it's just that there is not always something that needs to be said! But in any case, it never hurts to clue you all into what is happening around here.

The big news right now is the heat situation in the church. If you have been following this ongoing saga, we've wrestled with a leaking boiler section for almost a year now! The boilers are comprised of 12 cast iron sections that are bolted together, filled with water, and heated. That water is then pumped throughout the building for heat. The original problem occurred during our annual inspection last year, one section was found to be leaking. So a new section had to be ordered from China, which is where most of the iron castings are made nowadays. Of course, during COVID the proverbial "slow boat from China" became a reality! When the replacement casting arrived and was installed, it too leaked! I know, quality control! These sections cannot be repaired. So, back to China for a replacement! The latest chapter of this drama is that the replacement section is due here in the next week or so. Our contractors are diligently waiting to install it as soon as possible. They want to get paid! The good news, if any, out of this saga is that this was a repair covered by our insurance. So, we have the funds and are just waiting for the fix.

This brings us to this week's issue. The empty school building is maintained at about 55 degrees, while the Church, a building which we are regularly using, is without heat.

Two of the six circulating pumps that circulate the hot boiler water around the plant are on the fritz! As best we can determine, these are original pumps to the system, making them about 60+ years old! The bearings have failed and have been grinding on the inside of the pump for a while and have now given up the ghost. The hard part is the replacement costs. The pumps, motors, and connecting parts cost about \$4,500.00, before installation! And this repair is not covered by insurance or our maintenance contract. As I write this, it is Tuesday, hopefully by the time you read this on Sunday the pumps will have been replaced and the heat back up to temperature. Worst case we will still be shivering for another weekend.

I don't need to tell you that this repair is not in the budget! We will draw from our meager reserves to cover the cost of this repair. As I mentioned in an earlier Blog, any funds remaining in the mortgage account are being held in reserve for Capital Projects. However, these funds are depleting quicker than expected. Therefore, any contributions from the remaining Mortgage Collection, or Staying the Course envelopes will go toward the cost of repairing the heating system. Should you be able to contribute, you can use these envelopes or mark any contribution for BOILER REPAIR. As always, thank you for your help.

On a related note, we hope to have the envelopes in your packets changed over to the new Capital Projects designation by the next mailing with the March and April envelopes. An additional reminder, we no longer have to pay for the subscriptions to the Catholic Review so no need to use those envelopes, just discard them.

I'm rapidly running out of space, so I will have to hold the remaining items for my next blog.
