— Pope Francis introduced this Prayer to the Holy Family that he wrote himself, asking the faithful to pray with him for families throughout the world and for the work of the upcoming Synod of Bishops devoted to pastoral care of the family. Pope Francis has made Christian family life a central priority of his remarkable pontificate. For guidance and inspiration, he asks us to fix our gaze on the Holy Family of Nazareth.



We close the Christmas octave — the eight days following the birth of Christ — with a day honoring Mary as the Mother of God. This is usually a holy day of obligation, but since it falls on a Saturday in 2022, it is not this year. "Mary, the all-holy ever-virgin Mother of God, is the masterwork of the mission of the Son and the Spirit in the fullness of time. For the first time in the plan of salvation and because his Spirit had prepared her, the Father found the dwelling place where his Son and his Spirit could dwell among men. In this sense the Church's Tradition has often read the most beautiful texts on wisdom in relation to Mary. Mary is acclaimed and represented in the liturgy as the "Seat of Wisdom." — Catechism of the Catholic Church 721


