



<u>Stewardship Scripture Reflection</u> 2nd Sunday of Ordinary Time January 16, 2022

"To each individual the manifestation of the Spirit is given for some benefit." (1 CORINTHIANS 12:7)

St. Paul tells us that God has blessed each of us for a reason. How has God blessed you? Are you using your gifts according to God's plan? How are you helping to build God's kingdom here on earth? Remember that if you don't do the work God planned for you, no one else can do it. Live the life God has intended for you. Take time to discern your charisms (gifts from the Holy Spirit). Experience the supernatural Peace and Joy God desires for each of us His Stewards.

PARISH REGISTRATION

To enable us to better serve you, all parishioners should register at the Parish Office. If you are a new parishioner, or a current parishioner who has moved or changed phone numbers, please contact the Parish Office. Family members 23 years or older should register separately as

individuals even if continuing to live with their parents. You must be a registered parishioner to be a Confirmation Sponsor or a Godparent.

GODPARENT/CONFIRMATION SPONSOR REQUIREMENTS

- Must be an ACTIVE, REGISTERED parishioner for a minimum of six months, who attends Mass weekly, and contributes to the support of the Church. in accordance with one's means.
 - Must have received all the Sacraments of Initiation. (Baptism, Holy Eucharist, and Confirmation)
- If married, must be in a marriage recognized as valid by the Catholic Church.
 - Must live a Christian life consistent with the role of godparent or sponsor.

REGISTRO PARROQUIAL

- Debe vivir una vida cristiana consistente con el papel de padrino o patrocinador de confirmación.

Dear Friend,

Of all the classical Spiritual Disciplines, Christian Stewardship of Time Talent and Treasure is the most conductive to the growth of humility.

When we set out on a consciously chosen course of action that accents the good of others and is for the most part a hidden work, a deep change occurs in our interior spirit.

Nothing disciplines the inordinate desires of the flesh like Christian Stewardship, and nothing transforms the desires of the flesh like serving in "hiddenness."

The flesh whines against Christian Stewardship but screams against "hidden" Christian Stewardship.

It strains and pulls for honor and recognition. It will devise subtle, acceptable means to call attention to the service rendered.

If we stoutly refuse to give in to this "lust of the flesh" we will crucify it.

Every time we crucify the flesh we crucify our pride and arrogance.

To do this it is necessary to pray always and never lose heart.



From Fire, by Water My Journey to the Catholic Faith

Sohrab Ahmari was a teenager living under the Iranian ayatollahs when he decided that there is no God. Nearly two decades later, he would be received

into the Roman Catholic Church.

In *From Fire, by Water*, he recounts this unlikely passage, from the strident Marxism and atheism of a youth misspent on both sides of the Atlantic to a moral and spiritual awakening prompted by the Mass. At once a young intellectual's finely crafted selfportrait and a life story at the intersection of the great ideas and events of our time, the book marks the debut of a compelling new Catholic voice.
