**RITE OF CHRISTIAN INITIATION OF ADULTS (RCIA)...** RCIA is the process of welcoming new members to the Catholic Church. It is intended for adults who have never been baptized or for adults who have been baptized Christian and now wish to practice the faith in the Catholic tradition. It is an ongoing process of formation, catechesis and liturgical rites. Anyone interested is asked to call the rectory to discuss the process.

**PASTOR'S CORNER**

**Jesus: The Earthly Pattern and Heavenly Sanctuary**

The physical worship spaces and temple complexes of all religions in every time and place express outwardly a people's ultimate vision of reality and eternity. This is no less true of the tabernacle of God in the desert of Sinai, which Moses made "according to the pattern shown [him] on the mountain" (Exodus 25:40) and later constructed in stone in Jerusalem. (I Kings 6) The earthly temple was "a copy and a shadow of the heavenly sanctuary." (Hebrews 8:5)

Detailed extensively in Leviticus, the Holiness Code for legal purity was meant to stress the necessary sanctity that all must have in living in the community dedicated to God and approaching him in temple worship. All who were ritually unclean, like the leper in Leviticus 13, were isolated and had to be given a declaration of cleanness upon inspection by the temple priest before rejoining the community.

When he healed the leprous man (Mark 1:40-45), Jesus showed that he had come to give the holiness which is necessary to enter the heavenly sanctuary of his Mystical Body. For Israel's Temple and all others, for that matter, which "are shadows of the things to come; the reality belongs to Christ." (Colossians 2:17) This means that Jesus, as he went around healing, feeding, leading, and casting out demonic powers, is the new Temple of God.

When we hear then of the crowds gathered around Jesus, even as they came to him "outside in deserted places" (Mark 1:45), we are to understand the new people of God. "As Israel according to the flesh which wandered in the desert was already called the Church of God, so too, the new Israel, which advances in this present era in search of a future and permanent city is called also the Church of Christ." (Lumen Gentium 9, Vatican II)

The irony of the leper's cleansing is that as the healed man was reintegrated into the community, Jesus, due to the press of the crowds, could not "enter a town openly...but remained outside in deserted places." (v. 45) In effect they exchanged places, foretelling the mystery of the cross itself, where Jesus bore our infirmities and endured our sufferings (Isaiah 53:4) as an outcast on Calvary. "People kept coming to him from everywhere," (Mark 1:45) and that is the nature of the Church. In this world, made like a desert by sin, unbelief, and indifference, the Church exercises all the ministries of Jesus while she presses on in her "exodus" toward her heavenly homeland.





Statement on the Morality of Covid-19 Vaccines

The following statement is based on reports from the Vatican’s Congregation for the Doctrine of the Faith (CDF), the U.S. Conference of Catholic Bishops (USCCB) and the Catholic Health Association (CHA).

At this point in time, Moderna and Pfizer have both developed vaccines using mRNA, and without the use of controversial fetal cell lines. However, both vaccines have been tested using controversial fetal cell lines. Given the remote connection between these cells and the vaccines, both COVID vaccines are in line with previous moral statements made by Pope Benedict XVI and the Pontifical Academy for Life. Receiving either vaccine would be morally permissible and would certainly also be an important pro-life decision that would help to defend the most vulnerable members of our community, who are at the most risk of developing severe coronavirus cases.

This new statement from the CDF also clarifies that “when ethically irreproachable Covid-19 vaccines are not available...it is morally acceptable to receive Covid-19 vaccines that have used cell lines from aborted fetuses in their research and production process.” The AstraZeneca vaccine used controversial HEK293 lines (descended from two abortions that took place in the 1960s) in its development. However, because most people do not have a choice in the vaccine that they receive, it is morally permissible to take this vaccine in order to protect the lives of those who are most at risk of serious coronavirus.


