PASTOR'S NOTE

The True Bread from Heaven

*I am the bread of life... (John 6:35)*

During the next several Sundays, we continue with the Bread of Life discourse of Jesus from the 6<sup>th</sup> chapter of John, a detour when the Gospel of Mark is assigned every three years for the season of Ordinary Time.

Jesus wants us to raise our minds above earthly concerns of acquiring ordinary bread, which keeps body and soul together, as important as that is. He wants to give us the food “that endures for eternal life” (vs. 27).

The eternal life that this bread nourishes far surpasses the ancient Hebrew notion, that is, a life to be perpetuated in one’s children and in the memory of one’s descendants. It is more inviting than consignment to the shady existence of a subterranean abode of the dead. Eternal life is more than that of the Greek philosophers, where the soul lives forever freed from the shackles of the body. Attaining this kind of “eternal life” is easy. It entails merely living out our lives and then going the way of all flesh.

Jesus has something far greater in mind, an eternal life that can come only from God. Without a hint of exaggeration or metaphorical meaning, Jesus offers the disciples this life through a food that he promises. “I am the bread of life,” he declares (vs. 35). Thus we must conclude that he is not only a very special emissary from God, but Jesus has the divine nature of God himself.

Jesus provides this food and is himself that food. If we thus feed upon God, then there must be something hidden and invisible in this nourishment, and yet also something tangible and edible, because it is food. The notion of Transubstantiation may sound somewhat abstract, that is, that the substance of bread and wine changes, with the outward appearances—the accidents—detectable by the bodily senses remaining the same. But substance, in the proper sense of the term, is in itself invisible. This substance also includes his human nature, which Jesus has made invisible. It should come as no surprise. After all, in his resurrected body he appeared and disappeared from ordinary sight. Thereby, we can feed upon the sacrament of his Body and Blood in a normal way of eating. In this, the ancient Hebrew notion that there is no human life worth mentioning without the body also is fulfilled by resurrection from the dead. It is the living body of Jesus, invisible to our eyes, but really present with his divine nature, that we receive in the most holy sacrament of the Eucharist. *(continued at top)*

When I consider what draws us to Mass on Sunday, if not every day, it is the notion that we are even now caught up in and living the eternal life that Jesus gives. It is sustained on a regular basis by communion with him through word and sacrament. As of yet, much of the world is missing out on something very special!






