Catholic Stewardship Reflection

Today we celebrate the feast of the Most Holy Trinity. What we are commemorating is a central reality of our Christian faith, that God is Trinitarian in nature — three distinct persons in one God.

The Church calls this truth a mystery, as indeed it is. Some have said that "mystery" in this context is "not a wall to run up against but an ocean in which to swim." Contemplating the "ocean depths" of this mystery can make us humans feel so small, and almighty God so far from us. Yet nothing could be further from the truth as today's readings demonstrate. In the second reading, St. Paul reminds us that God is intimately connected to us. "The love of God has been poured out into our hearts through the Holy Spirit that has been given to us." God wants live in the very depths of our being and in all the intimate details of our lives if we will let Him. And in the Gospel from St. John, we learn that God holds back nothing of Himself from us. Jesus tells His disciples (this includes us!) that the Holy Spirit "will take from what is mine and declare it to you. Everything the Father has is mine." Thus, we find ourselves drawn right into the midst of this Trinitarian love. In fact, if the mystery of Holy Trinity is an ocean which to swim, the "water" that makes up that ocean is love. What then should be the response of the Christian steward to this sublime mystery? All we can do is worship. And offer our lives back to God in total gratitude for calling us to live in the richness of such unfathomable love.

FEAST OF SAINT GASPAR BERTONI



This Sunday, June 12th marks the Feast of Saint Gaspar Bertoni, (October 9, 1777-June 12, 1853). Gaspar Bertoni was the founder of the Congregation of the Sacred Stigmata, known to us as the Stigmatine. The order was established in 1816 in Verona, Italy. The first written constitutions for the congregation were based on the constitutions of Ignatius of Loyola, founder of the Society of Jesus, Jesu-

its. The Stigmatine congregation was rooted in missionary and educational ministry. The patrons of the Stigmatine Congregation are the Holy Spouses, Mary and Joseph. As we begin to celebrate the Centennial of our parish, we are reminded and appreciative to the many wonderful Stigmatine priests who dedicatedly served our parish from its founding through the first 75 years. Below is the prayer of the founder to the Blessed Virgin Mary.

Prayer of the Founder to the Blessed Virgin Mary

I greet you, O my Mother; give me your blessing; bless me and all who are dear to me. Please offer to God all I have to do and suffer today, in union with your merits, as well as those of your Blessed Son. I offer and consecrate to your service all my being and whatever belongs to me, placing everything under your protection. Obtain for me, dear Lady, purity of soul and body, and grant that I may not do anything today displeasing to God. I entreat you trough your Immaculate Conception and your perfect Virginity." Amen
