#### CATHOLIC STEWARDSHIP REFLECTION

In today's Gospel reading from St. Luke, we receive a reminder about the proper use of the gift of time, a fundamental aspect of a stewardship way of life. Our passage highlights one of the most famous dinner parties ever thrown, recalling the day that Martha

and Mary hosted our Lord in their home. We are told that Martha, as a good steward, welcomes Christ in but then becomes "burdened with much serving" while her sister and fellow hostess chooses to simply sit with Jesus, listening to Him speak. Martha becomes indignant at Mary's behavior and complains to Jesus, "Lord, do you not care that my sister has left me by myself to do the serving? Tell her to help me." But Jesus, in His



infinite wisdom, refuses to get pulled into this sisterly spat. Instead, He offers Martha a fresh way to look at the situation. "Martha, Martha, you are anxious and worried about many things. There is need of only one thing." What is that one thing? It is to put Jesus first in our lives and above all other things; to "sit at his feet" and listen as Mary did, giving Him the priority of our time no matter how busy we think we are. When we truly commit to putting Christ first in our daily lives through a regular time of prayer and frequent participation in the sacraments, we will find that all our other concerns become less pressing, less overwhelming. Why is this so? Because the time we invest in our relationship with God saturates all aspects of our lives with His grace. And because God cannot be outdone in generosity. He will abundantly reward any sacrifice we make to spend time with Him.

#### RITE OF CHRISTIAN INITIATION OF ADULTS

Do you know someone who has questions about the Catholic Faith? Do you know someone who is interested in becoming a member of the Catholic Church? Anyone over the age of 7 years old who has never been baptized is welcomed into the Church through the Rite of Christian Initiation of Adults. Those who have been baptized in another Christian Church are welcomed after making a profession of faith and receiving the Sacrament of Confirmation. Please invite anyone you know who is interested in becoming a Catholic to join you at Mass and to call the parish office for more information.

#### REQUIREMENTS FOR BEING A GODPARENT

The Church requires that individuals filling the role of a Godparent be baptized and confirmed Catholics living a life in accordance with the teachings of the Church. Individuals who have not been confirmed or have been married in a civil ceremony do not meet these requirements. Often this can be remedied by receiving the sacraments of Confirmation and Holy Matrimony prior to the upcoming baptism. Confirmations take place throughout the year in the diocese and a couple may have their civil marriage "convalidated" in their local parish. Please call Fr. #### HEARTBEAT PREGNANCY HELP CENTER

The overturning of Roe v Wade calls us all to take the next step in supporting expectant mothers and the infants and children in their care. A wonderful way to do this is to support pregnancy health centers like Heartbeat in Burlington, MA. Last year, Heartbeat provided layette and other items for 670 babies and the need this year is even greater. If you wish to purchase items to donate, most needed are: sleepers (0-3 mo. and 3-6 mo), BPA-free baby bottles, and BOYS toddler clothing. Sizes 2-3 T. For those who prefer, donations of gift cards for stores including Target, Walmart and Market Basket are also gratefully accepted. Monetary gifts are ideal since the Heartbeat staff has the ability to purchase items such as diapers, formula, car seats and other essentials at cost and tax -free. Those who wish to donate should make checks payable to "Heartbeat". Donations may be brought to the church when you attend Mass and we will transport items weekly to Heartbeat.. #### BEREAVEMENT MINISTRY

Fr. Kennedy would like to gather a group of people who are willing to assist in planning for and serving at funerals for deceased parishioners. This would include getting information from funeral directors, setting up the church and assisting at the Mass. Very often Fr. Kennedy is coming from another engagement prior to the funeral and will leave immediately following the Mass to accompany families to the cemetery for committal. #### PARISH REPAIR/IMPROVEMENT PROJECTS

The facilities inspector from the Archdiocese identified a number of repairs and improvements that need to be done in the three parish buildings. A number of these require professional expertise. Four projects that can easily be accomplished by parishioners are

- 1. Cutting back hedges and trees at least 18 inches from the Church building (later trimming the hedges around the parking lot).
- 2. Filling and placing sandbags at the Grove St entrance to the parking lot (to prevent rain runoff and debris from clogging drains in parking lot). The bags have already been purchased.
- 3. Scraping, puttying and painting the 12 half-moon windows in the rectory.
- 4. Scraping the paint in the parish hall (perhaps painting also). Father Kennedy is asking parishioners to consider organizing groups for these projects to be completed by the end of September. The parish will pay for the painting materials. This is our parish and we need to maintain the physical plant. Thank you in advance.
