RCIA


The Rite of Christian Initiation of Adults is an ongoing process. Those interested in exploring the Catholic faith through the RCIA should contact the religious education office.

RITE OF CHRISTIAN INITIATION OF ADULTS

REQUIREMENTS FOR BEING A GODPARENT

The Church requires that individuals filling the role of a Godparent be baptized and confirmed Catholics living a life in accordance with the teachings of the Church. Individuals who have not been confirmed or have been married in a civil ceremony do not meet these requirements. Often this can be remedied by receiving the sacraments of Confirmation and Holy Matrimony prior to the upcoming baptism. Confirmations take place throughout the year in the diocese and a couple may have their civil marriage "convalidated" in their local parish. Please call Fr. 
Centennial Mass
