Today's Gospel passage comes as a pat on the back from Heaven for all of us striving to live a stewardship way of life. It reminds us why we live the way we do and why we make the choices we make. Let's face it, if we truly embrace this way of life, there will be people who find our choices - based on serving God and others - downright foolish. But let's see what God thinks. Spoiler alert: turns out Christian stewards are not the fools! In this passage, Jesus makes it clear that life is not about "stuff" as he tells the parable of the wealthy businessman who thought he had everything figured out. The man had such an abundance of stuff that he didn't have room to store it all. So, thinking of earthly things and not on what is above, he decided to build a bigger place to store all that stuff. Patting himself on the back, he thought about what good times he would have in the years ahead. But Jesus tells us that day would turn out to be the man's last day on the earth. And he had spent it thinking only of himself. How foolish!

#### SATURDAY AFTERNOON SOCIALS

Beginning in August our Saturday Social following the 4:00 PM Mass will shift to once a month and be held on the 2nd Saturday of each month. This is an opportunity for people to remain after Mass and socialize. People are encouraged to bring some refreshments for themselves and to share with others. We will meet in the parking lot (weather permitting) or the parish hall.

#### HVAC FUNDRAISER

As previously mentioned, we need to replace the controller system for the HVAC system in the parish. Thanks to your generosity, the air handling system was replaced in the spring and our air conditioning has kept the church at a pleasant temperature during our recent heat wave. The controller system will link new thermostats to the boiler and allow us to control the heat in the church. Last winter the old system failed. As a result, we had to pay \$7,000.00 for natural gas for two months until we were able to manually override the system. We are reviewing the bids for the work but will need to raise approximately twenty thousand dollars for this project. This is a lot of money but the new system will allow us to make significant savings in our energy costs in the coming winters. We will announce the new fundraising effort next month. We realize that with the current high inflation families are facing difficult financial situations and appreciate your assistance.

#### **RITE OF CHRISTIAN INITIATION OF ADULTS**

Those who have been baptized in another Christian Church are welcomed after making a profession of faith and receiving the Sacrament of Confirmation. #### **REQUIREMENTS FOR BEING A GODPARENT**

The Church requires that individuals filling the role of a Godparent be baptized and confirmed Catholics living a life in accordance with the teachings of the Church. Individuals who have not been confirmed or have been married in a civil ceremony do not meet these requirements. Often this can be remedied by receiving the sacraments of Confirmation and Holy Matrimony prior to the upcoming baptism. Confirmations take place throughout the year in the diocese and a couple may have their civil marriage "convalidated" in their local parish. Please call Fr.
