SACRAMENT OF RECONCILIATION Due to Covid, Confessions are available by appointment.


SACRAMENT OF THE SICK

Please notify the parish office if you or a family member is hospitalized or homebound and desires to receive the Eucharist and/or the Sacrament of the Anointing of the Sick.






JUST A THOUGHT ... FROM FR. DAN

Lector afternoon of Reflection

<u>In the Beginning Was the Word</u>

In Isaiah 55 we read:

"For as the rain and the snow come down from heaven,

And do not return there without watering the earth

And making it produce and sprout,

And providing seed to the sower and bread to the eater;

So will my Word be which goes out of my mouth;

It will not return to me empty,

Without accomplishing what I desire."

This is the task of the lector to prayerfully proclaim the Word. With this in mind, Fr Dan invites new and returning lectors to an afternoon of reflection on Sunday, Nov. 9^{th,} from 1 to 2 pm in the upper Church. This moment of prayer will emphasize both spiritual and practical preparation and invite both experienced and beginning lectors to develop their understanding of the ministry of proclaiming the Word of God and review some skills needed to do it well. We will prayerfully look at the many aspects of the lector's work, ministry, and vocation. It will allow us to reflect on the mystery of God who speaks to and through us in the power of His Word.

New Mask Mandate in Effect December 18th -January 17th

In the light of spiking numbers of new COVID cases and the likely increase in those numbers in the upcoming holiday season, Cardinal Seán is mandating that throughout the archdiocese all people attending public Masses, including weddings and funerals, wear masks. This mandate takes effect the weekend of December 18/19, 2021, and expires on January 17, 2022.

Mass celebrants, deacons, readers, servers, choir members, and instrumentalists, should all wear masks except when they are speaking.

Children under the age of five are not required to wear masks. Children under the age of two should not wear masks.

In addition, all churches must continue to provide a designated area in which social distancing is respected for those who want to use it.
