JUST A THOUGHT ... FROM FR. DAN

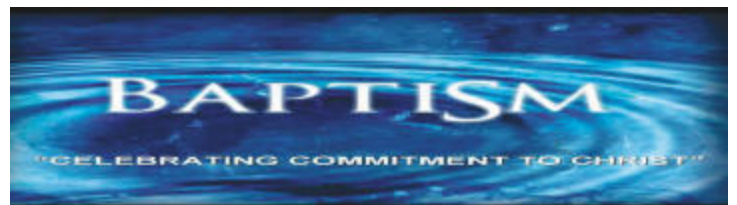

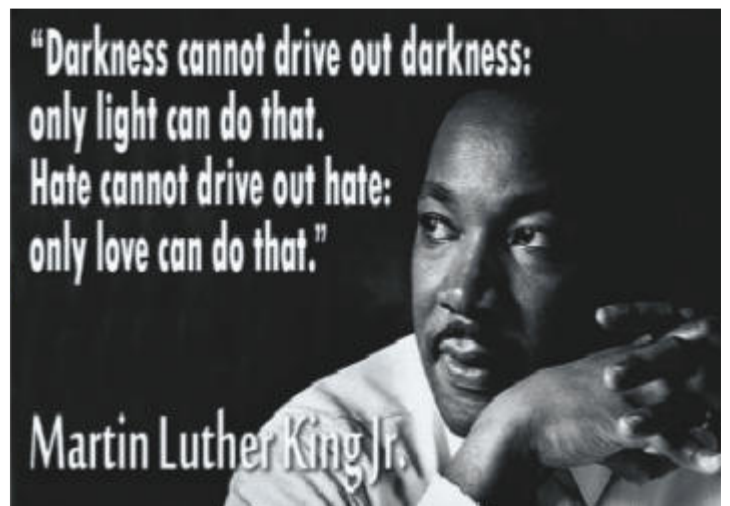
