SACRAMENT OF MATRIMONY


Couples desiring marriage in the Church should contact the parish office for details at least six months prior to the anticipated date of their wedding.

Pope Francis has established throughout the Church the <u>celebration of the World Day for Grandparents</u> and Elderly on the **fourth Sunday of July**, near the liturgical memorial of Saints Joachim and Anne, the grandparents of Jesus. The announcement of this celebration coincided with the celebration of the Year of Amoris Laetitia Family, which began on the Solemnity of Saint Joseph the husband of Mary, on March 19, 2021, and concluded at the World Meeting of Families in Rome in June of 2022.

The next World Day for Grandparents and Elderly is July 24, 2022. The theme for this year's celebration is "In Old Age They Will Still Bear Fruit" (Ps. 92:15). The theme is meant to emphasize how grandparents are a gift both to society and the Church. For more information on the theme please see the Dicastery for Laity, Family, and Life's announcement. This year, Pope Francis is also extending the opportunity for a <u>plenary indulgence</u> "to the faithful who devote adequate time to visit, in presence or virtually, through the media, their elderly brothers and sisters in need or in difficulty" on July 24.




