Deacon's Corner



“How did you meet?”

My wife Noreen and I met on New Year's Eve December 31, 1972/January 1, 1973. On that evening I was about to leave my parent's home for my fraternity's party at Merrimack College in North Andover, MA when I received a call from my friend Phil. He asked me if I would accompany his girlfriend's friend to a party in Salem MA. At the last minute I changed my plans and headed to Salem. Long story short, I met the friend at the party but we didn't hit it off. I ended up meeting Noreen there and driving her home at the end of the evening. We dated for the next two and a half years and were married on 9/27/75 at Saint Ann's Church in Peabody, MA.

For many years, Noreen and I volunteered to work with engaged couples preparing to be married in the Catholic Church. As a session icebreaker, we would often ask the engaged couples to share with each other how they met. Many met through school, work, volunteer activities, or through relatives or friends. What came out in these stories was often the fact that many prayed for God to connect them to someone who would be a good spouse for them. For those of you who are married, have you shared with your family how you met? Did you see God working to bring you together? In the engaged couples preparation programs we shared the idea that since God brought the two of you together, you are a gift to each other from God; therefore, treat each other as such.

On that New Year's Eve that Noreen and I met, I wasn't supposed to be at the party I attended. I also was not supposed to be with Noreen. God does have a plan for each of us and He often works in mysterious ways and in His timeframe. For those of you who are not married and feel called to the marriage vocation, as many of the engaged couples shared above, pray for guidance and an introduction to the person that God wants you to spend your life with. Once married, treat that person as the unique gift to you from God that he/she is.

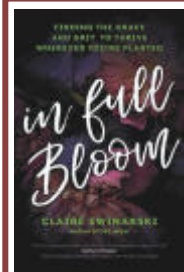

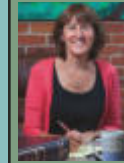
